- The SW/Buzzard Point Flood Resilience Strategy has designed an integrated network of Blue/Green Infrastructure (BGI) to protect the SW and the Buzzard Point communities from interior flooding due to extreme rain events. The Strategy's implementation is already partially funded through a mix of local and FEMA funding which will be used to redesign two large parks next to several public housing communities.*
