

**TPB Technical Committee Meeting Highlights**

**September 3, 2004**

The Technical Committee met on Friday, September 3 at COG. Three items were reviewed for inclusion on the TPB agenda on September 15.

- TPB agenda Item 8

The Committee was given a status report on work for the air quality conformity assessment and the current and proposed transportation emission reduction measures (TERMs) for the 2004 CLRP and the FY 2005-2010 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The Committee also was briefed on revisions to the draft FY 2005-2010 TIP document.

- TPB agenda Item 9

Staff briefed the Committee on new air quality conformity requirements for the Washington region under the EPA's recent 8-hour ozone rule, and on the proposed new non-attainment area designations for PM 2.5. The Committee reviewed how the conformity test for the region could be conducted and agreed that retaining Stafford County in both budgets and emissions estimates should be recommended as the conformity test to the TPB. The Committee also was briefed on the 8-hour conformity assessment draft scope of work and the project submissions for 2010.

- TPB agenda Item 11

Staff presented the first phase results of the five land use scenarios being assessed in the Regional Mobility and Accessibility Study. A "citizen-friendly" presentation on these results is scheduled to be presented at the Citizens Advisory Committee meeting on September 9, at the Joint Technical Working Group (JTWG) meeting on September 10, and at the TPB meeting on September 15.

Two items were presented for information and discussion:

- The Committee was briefed on the draft document: 2003 Update to the Financially Constrained Long-Range Transportation Plan.
- The Committee received a briefing on the draft 2004 State of Commute Survey Technical Report.
