





- Steering Committee holds implementation meetings every two months
- Local collaboration on data and outreach ideas
- Lead agencies are Department of Public Works and Transportation and the Police Department

- Traffic Safety Advisory Board created by 2013 legislation to develop, implement, and evaluate a local SHSP
- Plan for 2021-2025 approved by TSAB in May 2021

Lead agency is Sheriff's Office








- Strategic Road Safety Plan was finalized and published in 2020
- Data analysis collaboration under development with Office of Transportation and Police Department

 Lead agency is Office of Transportation







- Steering Committee meeting monthly
- Plan for 2021-2025 complete with 2020 crash data and going out for public comment
- Will go before the County Council for approval



- Draft plan approved and updated to 2020 crash data
- County Board of Commissioners will be approached for endorsement

 Lead agency is Office of Transportation

 Lead agencies are Department of Public Works and Sheriff's Office

- FHWA Speed Management Action Plan (SMAP) Workshop report and Complete Streets Policy used as resource materials
- Toward Zero Baltimore plan will be updated with 2020 crash data
- Lead agency is Department of Transportation

- Initial data review and problem identification shared with local partners in 2019
 - Will be updated with 2020 crash data

CRASHES ARE NO ACCIDENT

Maryland takes a data-driven approach to reach our goal of zero roadway fatalities and serious injuries.
