

# **Crystal City/Potomac Yard Transitway (Alexandria)**

Regional Public Transportation Subcommittee June 23, 2015

#### Route 1 Transitway

OF ALEXANDER CO. DR. CINIE

- 5-mile corridor between Pentagon City and Braddock Road Metrorail stations
  - 80% in dedicated right-of-way
- Operations:
  - Extension of 9S to Potomac Yard
  - New 9X route serving entire corridor
  - Other routes able to use dedicated lanes and benefit from faster travel times
- Expected daily ridership of 3,570 by 2017
- First 0.8 mile segment in Alexandria opened August 2014
- Arlington portion under construction



#### Project Overview

E PREINIE

- 2-lane transit-only corridor with 12-ft landscaped medians on both sides
  - Route 1 northbound widened by Potomac Yard South developer
  - Northbound lanes relocated to the east
  - Former northbound lanes repurposed for transitway
- Medians taper to allow for left-turn lanes at signalized intersections
- 7 transitway stations within dedicated ROW
  - E Glebe Rd SB (NB in Potomac Yard)
  - E Swann Ave 2 stations, far side
  - E Custis Ave 2 stations, far side
  - Potomac Ave –2 stations, north side of intersection




