TPB Technical Committee Meeting Highlights

October 6, 2006

The Technical Committee met on Friday, October 6 at COG. Six items were reviewed for inclusion on the TPB agenda on October.

TPB agenda Item 7

The Committee was briefed on the performance of the 2006 CLRP, including the expected land use changes, the financial picture, and highway and transit travel growth and congestion.

TPB agenda Item 9

Staff updated the Committee on the draft results of the air quality conformity assessment for the 2006 CLRP and FY 2007-2012 TIP. The Committee recommended that the conformity determination be approved at the October 18 TPB meeting.

TPB agenda Item 10

The Committee was briefed on the draft CLRP and FY 2007- 2012 TIP documents and web-based information. The Committee recommended that the 2006 CLRP be approved at the October 18 TPB meeting.

TPB agenda Item 11

The Committee reviewed some minor technical corrections for portions of the draft FY 2007-2012 TIP. It recommended that the FY 2007-2012 TIP with these corrections be approved at the October 18 TPB meeting.

TPB agenda Item 13

The Committee was briefed on the technical documentation of the Phase I analysis and results of the Regional Mobility and Accessibility Scenario Study.

TPB agenda Item 14

Staff briefed the Committee on a pilot program to promote coordination between land use and transportation planning. This new initiative will provide a regional clearinghouse to document local and state experience, and offer technical assistance to localities through a consultant team. The Committee recommended that this pilot program be advanced for approval by the TPB.

One item was presented for information and discussion:

 Staff briefed the Committee on the recent Fredericksburg Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (FAMPO) resolutions which present its policies with respect to the allocation and sharing of FTA formula funds for the Washington urbanized area. Staff also reviewed a draft letter to FAMPO outlining potential TPB responses and recommendations on each of the FAMPO policies. This draft letter will be subject to further review by the Committee at its November 3 meeting.

•	A briefing on the analysis of a regional system of variably priced lanes (VPLs) developed for the Regional Mobility and Accessibility Study was deferred until the November 3 meeting.
