









Event Growth by Year

- Response rate 21 percent
- Measures impact of event on bicycle commuting
- Survey results used in Regional Transportation Demand Management Program Analysis





Respondent Age Breakdown



Respondent Home and Work States


State	Home	Work

Favorite Aspects of Event Experience





- Bicycle Ownership for Event
 - Personal bike 94%
 - Capital Bikeshare 5%
 - Other 1%
- Bicycle Type Used for Event
 - Traditional pedal-bike 91%
 - Electric bike/pedal-assist 9%



- Prior to Event
 14% of respondents
 never commuted by
 bicycle
- After Event
 20% of respondents
 started bicycling to work
 or increased frequency
