**Realizing Rosslyn: Planning for Rosslyn’s Second Generation of Redevelopment**

Realize Rosslyn is a new effort to promote public participation in a community planning process aimed at realizing the transformation of Rosslyn from a 1960’s auto-centric area into a vibrant and distinctive urban place featuring great housing, retail and office space. The intense, one-year planning effort will be the most comprehensive look at planning in Rosslyn since the 1992 Rosslyn Station Area Plan Addendum. The results of this effort will provide a refined community vision, planning and implementation framework to help Rosslyn reach its full potential, while ensuring the voices across Arlington are part of this conversation (Arlington County Government Website).
