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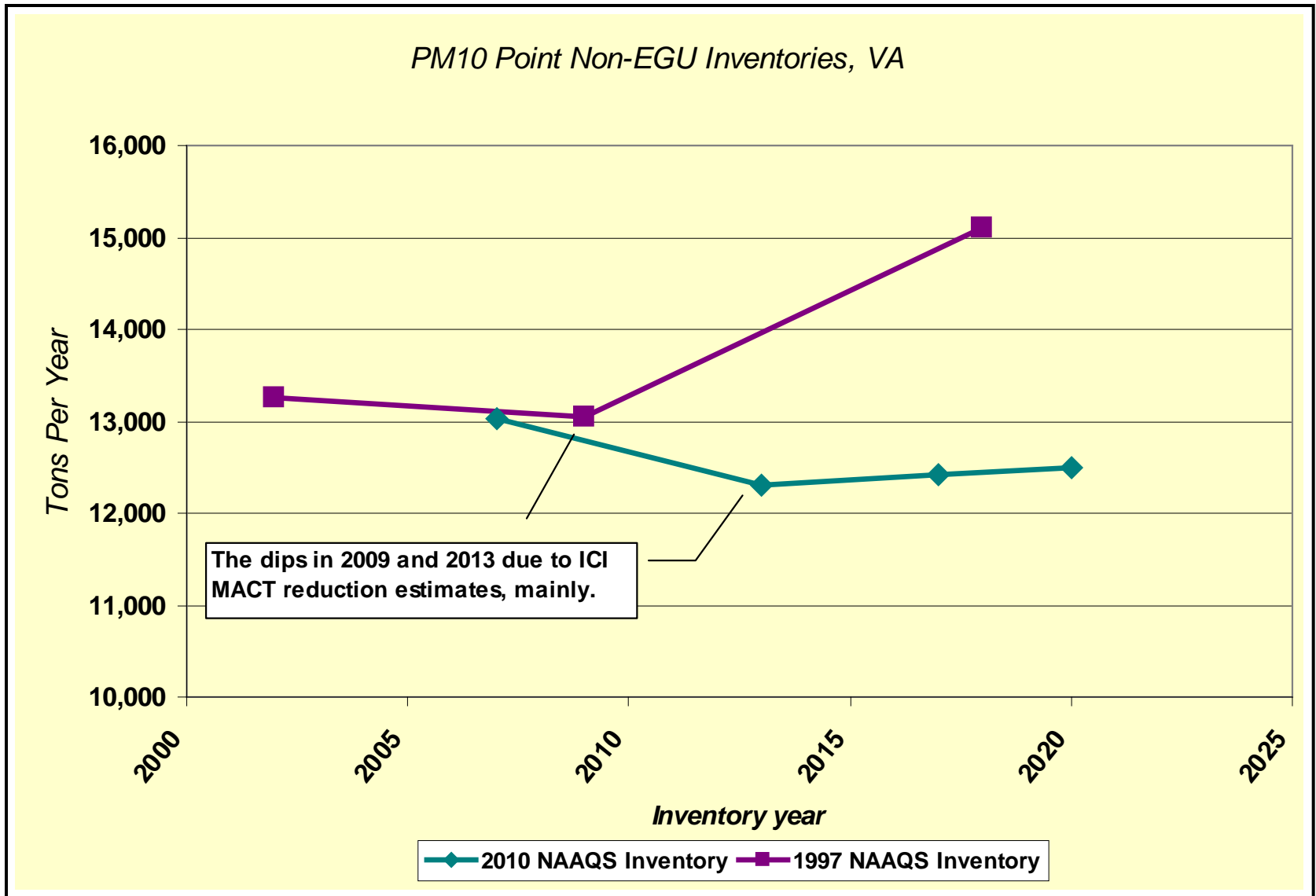
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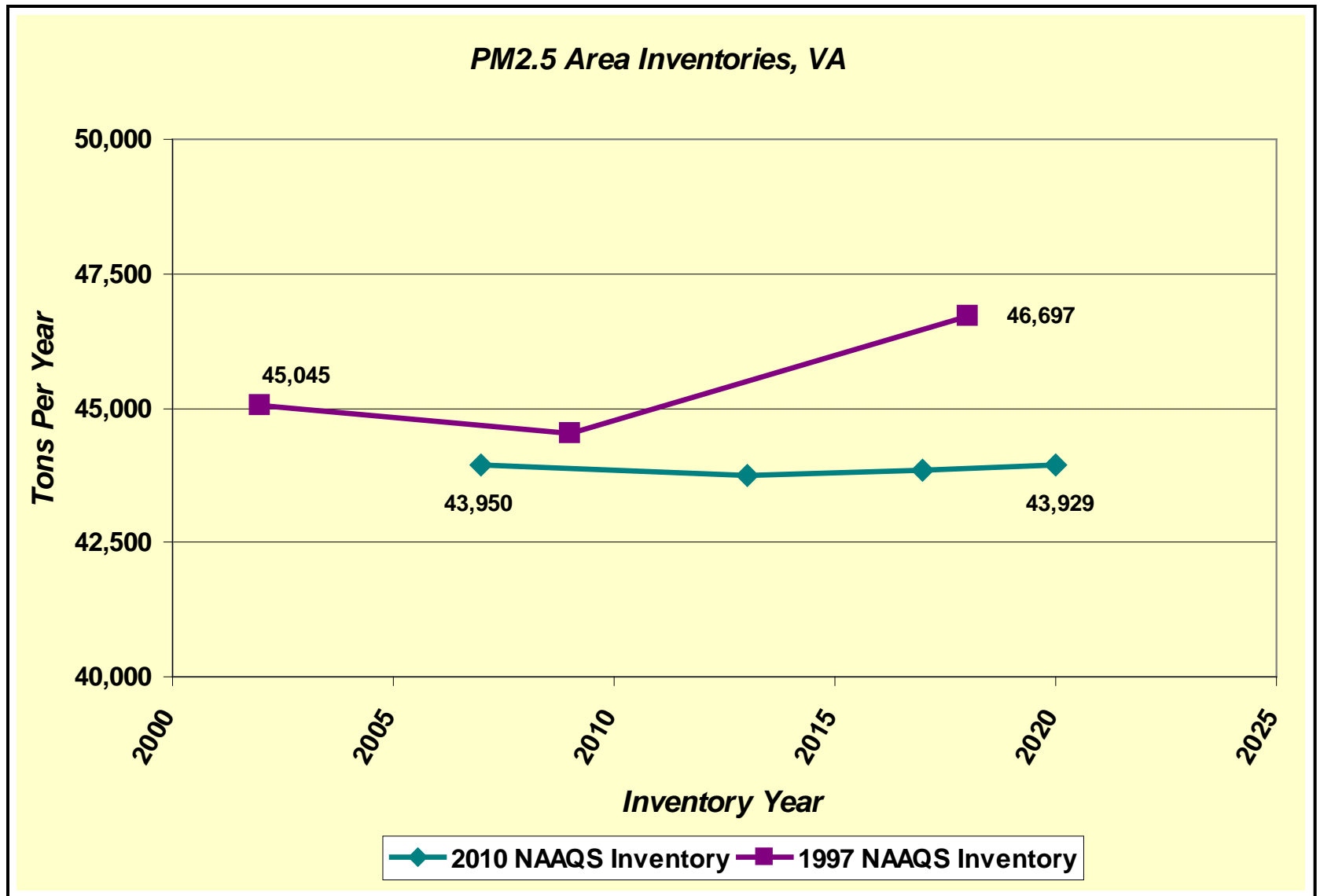
Things to Remember....

- The 1997 NAAQS Inventory Data:
 - 2008 Best and Final Inventory
 - Copious use of EPA's EGAS program
- The 2010 NAAQS Inventory Data:
 - Not final: DRAFT!!!
 - Area Inventory: is missing some categories like MAR, Wildland Fires
 - Point Non-EGU Inventory accounts for:
 - Consent Order reductions
 - Permit requirement reductions
 - ICI MACT reduction estimates
 - Point Non-EGU Inventory does NOT account for:
 - Negative growth
 - Shutdowns without federal requirements
 - Controls where there are no federal requirements

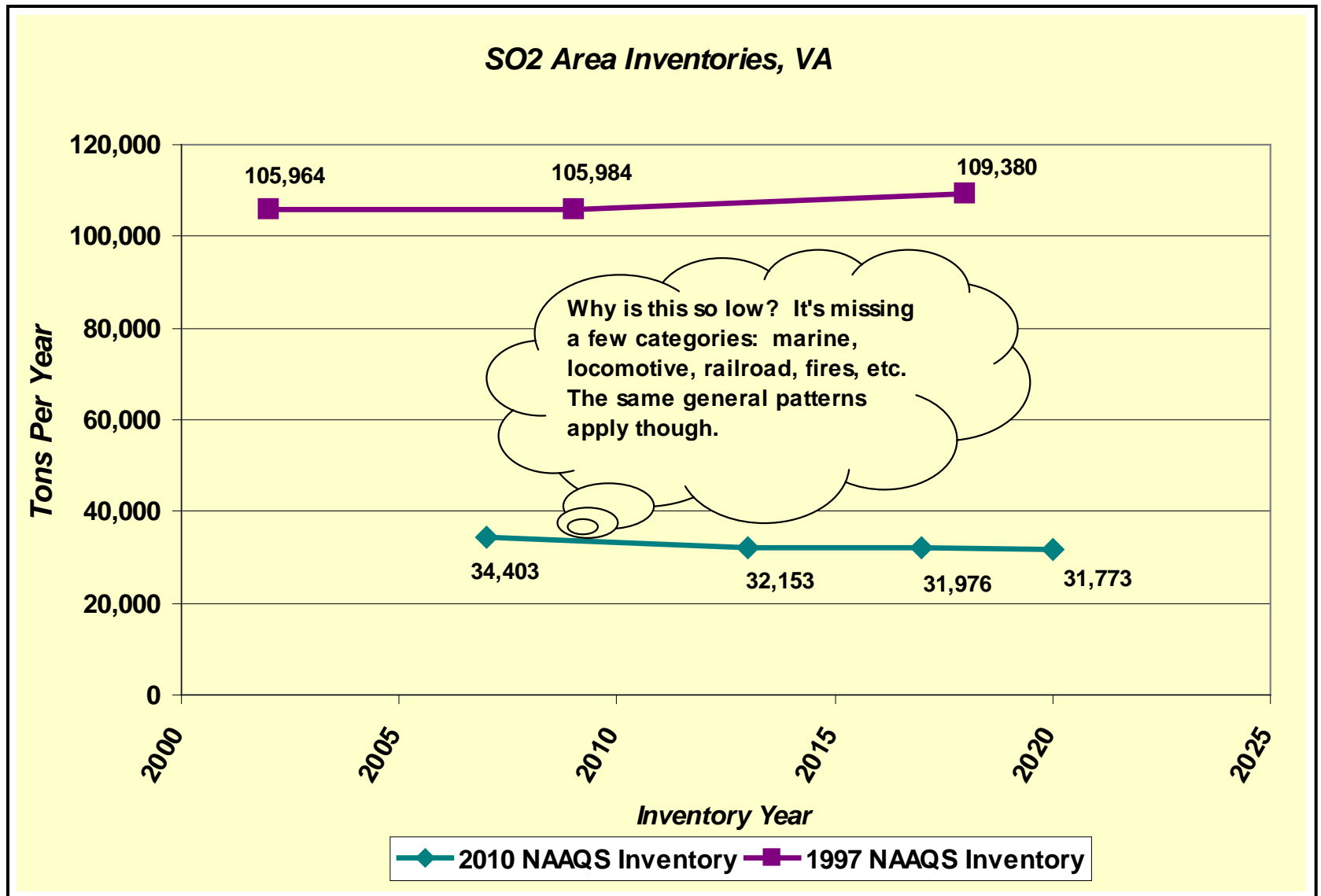
2010 NAAQS Inventory is DRAFT: Do Not Quote or Cite!!!



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What effects might the different growth rates have?

- Reductions from controls less likely to be subsumed by growth
- Fewer control programs may be needed to meet CAA requirements:
 - RFP
 - Contingencies
 - Attainment reductions
- Others???
