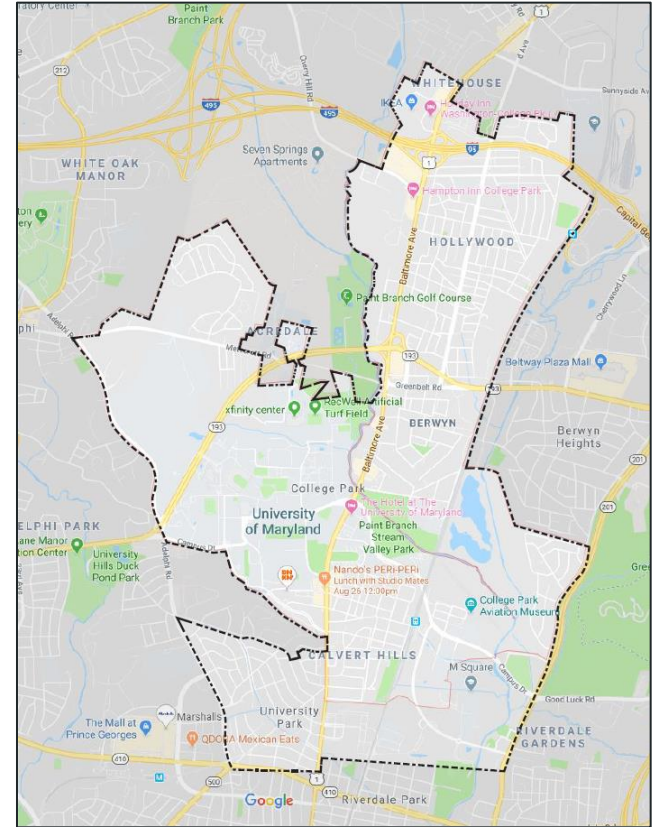

- 3-Year contract agreement with operator Veo executed in July 2022



Fleet Operations

- 400 vehicle cap
- Hours of Operations
 - On campus: E-bikes 24/7 & E-scooters 5 am - 10 pm
 - College Park & University Park: 24/7 for all vehicles

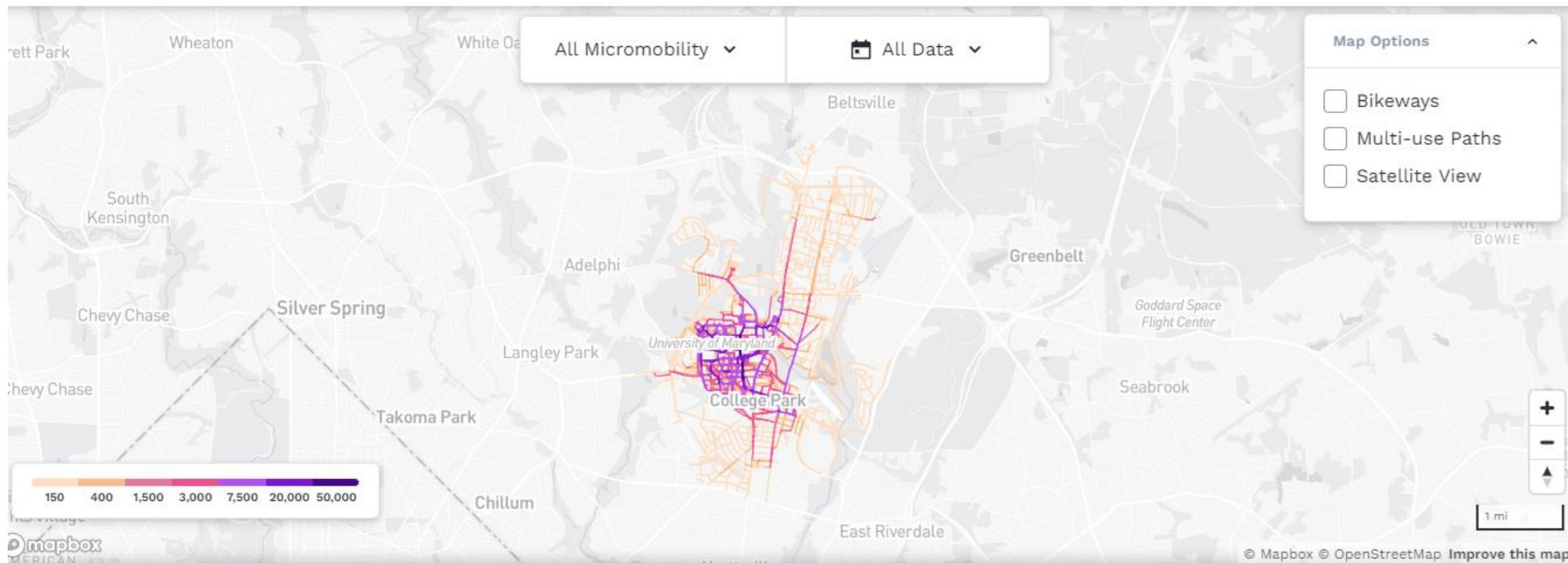
Parking Management

- Vehicles can park at bike racks or designated corrals
- Forced geofence parking across service areas. Meter continues to run outside of the approved parking areas
- Veo is fined for every stray vehicle reported and not relocated within 2 hours

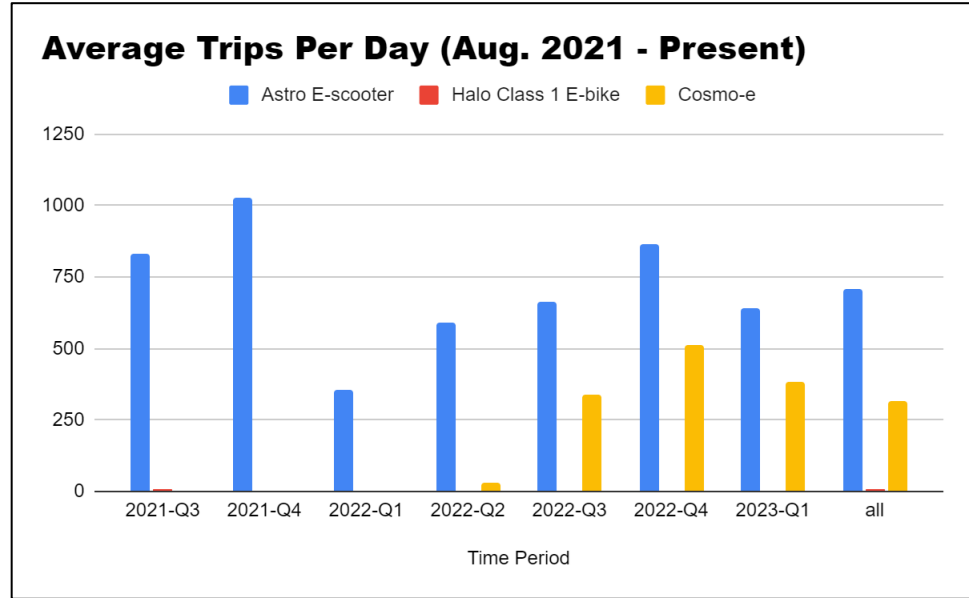

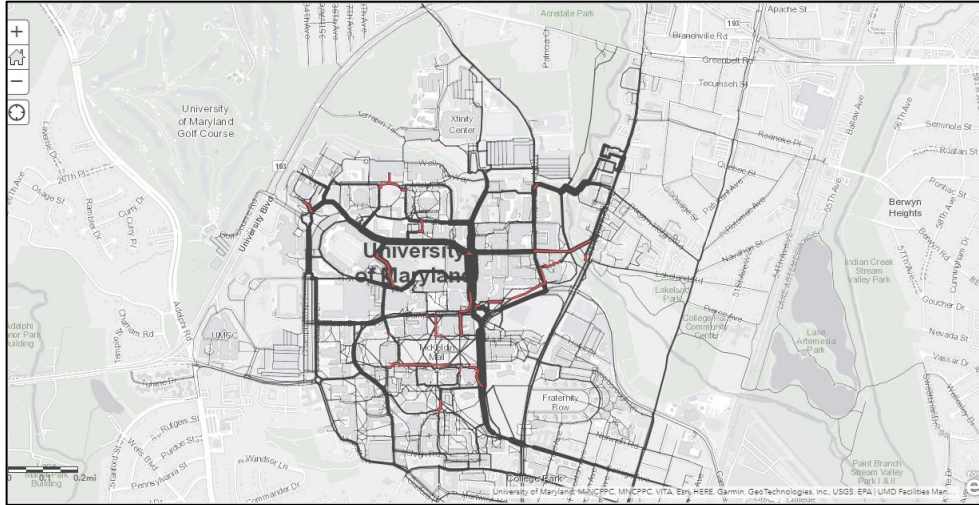

Ground Markings:

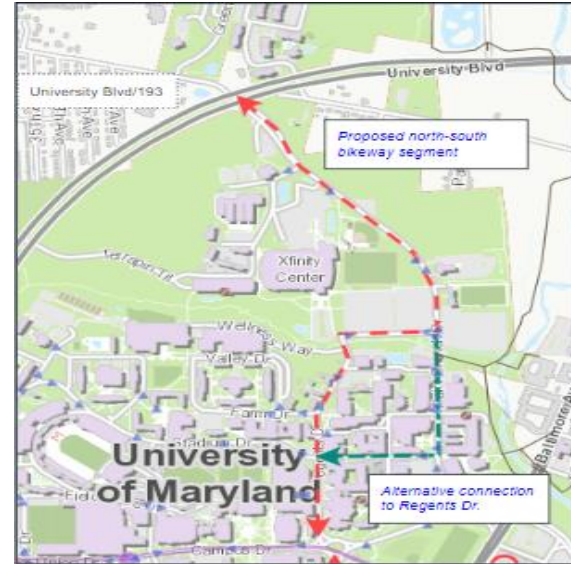


Vertical Signage:

Bikeways Feasibility Study kicking off Summer 2023

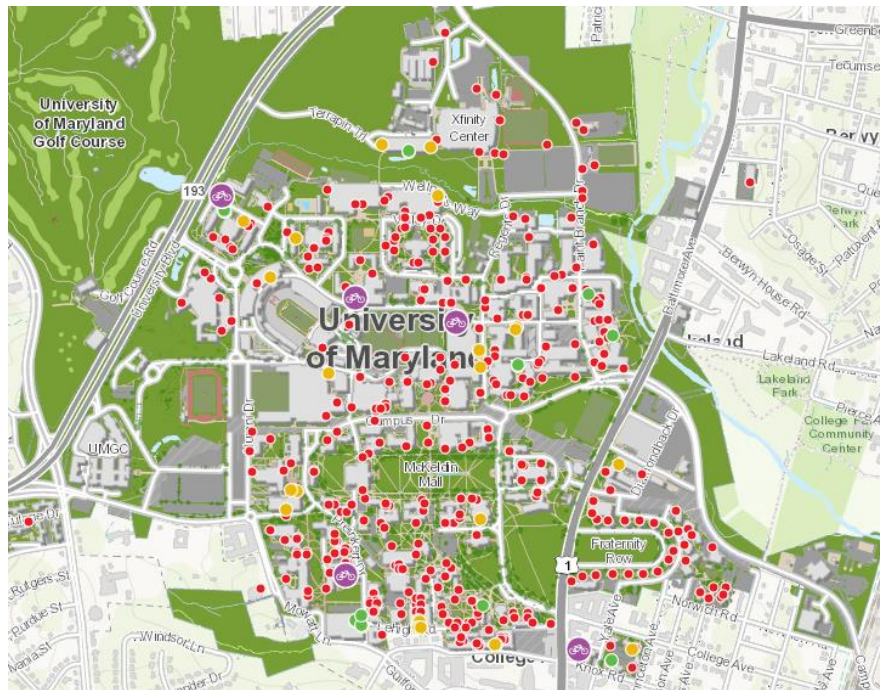


What's Next: Mandatory E-Scooter & E-bike Registration

- Mandatory E-Scooter & E-bike Registration
- Provide updated counts of vehicles on campus roadways
- Support communications, safe riding education, and enforcement mechanisms
- Fees collected will cover the cost of the sticker and used to fund additional micromobility facilities needed

What's Next: Capital Bikeshare Coming to College Park

- Capital Bikeshare Agreements Executed
