**RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO EXECUTIVE SESSION TO DISCUSS RESULTS OF THE PHYSICAL
SURVEY OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT BUILDINGS**

WHEREAS, at the direction of the Board of Directors, COG has conducted a survey of the physical security of local government buildings in the COG jurisdictions in the metropolitan Washington region and the results of that survey have been compiled; and

WHEREAS, the Board has been advised by the COG Police Chiefs Committee that issues regarding local government building security should not be discussed in open meeting because the sensitivity of the information may impact the security of such buildings; and

WHEREAS, discussion of reports and plans related to the security of a local government building or safety of persons using such building may be the subject of closed meetings in at least one COG jurisdiction and, therefore, is appropriate for discussion in closed meeting by the Board of Directors pursuant to Rule of Procedure 4.10.
