




Background:	At the January 28 meeting, the Board was briefed on initial results from the survey of over 10,000 households in the Washington Metropolitan region.









Factors Influencing Shift to Transit Metrorail Extensions Increased Local Bus Service Smart Benefits/Metrochek More Flexible Work Hours

- Program Started in 2000
- 50,000 Metrochek Users in 2000
- 190,000 Smart Benefits Users in 2008
- 62% of Transit Commuters in the HTS said they received a transit benefit

- 40% Work Fixed Work Schedule
- 30% Work Flexible, But Fixed Schedule
- 22% Completely Flexible
- 4% 10-Hour, Four Day Work Week
