

VIRGINIA 2013 ELECTION

- Republicans Lose Control
- Two Years of Divided Government Upcoming
 - **♦** Governor: McAuliffe (D)
 - ♦ House: Strongly Republican (66 seats)
 - Senate: Undecided
 - ◆ Two seats in question
 - **♦** Lieutenant Governor-elect Northam (D)
 - ◆ Either Senator Obenshain (R) or Senator Herring (D)

2014 GENERAL ASSEMBLY SESSION

- "Long" 60 Day Session
- Stormwater Issues Expected To Be Primary Water Issues

VSMP PROGRAM FEES

- Issue #1: Whether To Eliminate State Water Control Board's Oversight Of Local Fee Schedules
 - ♦ Locality must have approval to increase or decrease fees
 - Amendment to allow a locality to fund VSMP program through such sources deemed appropriate by the local governing body, without oversight
- Issue #2: Whether To Reduce State's 28% Share Of VSMP Fee

LOCAL VSMP HEARINGS

- Statute Requires
 - ▲ APA-style "formal" hearing for local actions
 - "Trial-like" process: verbatim record; depositions; subpoena of persons & documents; witness fees and mileage expenses
- Too Much For Local Land Development Decision
- Inconsistent With E&S, Which Allows For Less Formal Process
- Issue: Whether To Conform VSMP "Trial-like" Hearing Procedures to Long-Standing E&S Procedures

COMMON PLAN OF DEVELOPMENT

- Lots < 1 Acre, But Part Of Common Plan Of Development, Require Permit
- Duplicative, Unnecessarily Burdensome Where Developer Already Provides Stormwater Controls
- Issue: Whether To Allow Individual Lots In Same Development An Abbreviated Permit Process
 - Permit By Rule

AGREEMENT IN LIEU

- Current Requirement
 - Single family home construction subject to full regulations
 - ♦ Big burden on homeowner
- Issue: Whether to Give VSMP Authority Option to Require Agreement In Lieu
 - ♦ For single family homes
 - ♦ Similar to E&S Agreement in Lieu

OTHER ISSUES

- BMP Approved Reciprocity
 - Require VA to continue to allow recognition of certification programs of other states for BMPs
 - Draft DEQ regulations would eliminate reciprocity
- Stormwater Construction General Permit
 - Remove duplicative post-construction stormwater requirements covered by VSMP permit from the Construction GP

MARYLAND 2014 ELECTION

- Gubernatorial Election Next Year
 - Competition for party nominations
- Candidates Will Likely Debate Controversial Environmental Issues During 2014 GA Session
 - Election season will add fuel to fire on already contentious issues

2014 GENERAL ASSEMBLY SESSION

- 90 day session (as always)
- Convenes Jan. 8; Ends April 7
- Expected Environmental Issues
 - **♦** Stormwater
 - ♦ Local planning and growth issues

LOCAL STORMWATER FEES

- HB 987 (2012) Required Phase I MS4 To Establish Watershed Protection and Restoration Program
 - Unless jurisdiction already had system of charges
 - Must include a fee and a fund
 - ◆ Fund to pay for local stormwater management plans
- Many Localities Object
 - One did not adopt; using general fund to pay costs
 - ◆ Pre-filed legislation to repeal 2012 law

ACCOUNTING FOR GROWTH

- In WIP, MD Agreed To Establish Program To Account for Future Growth
 - ◆ State expects to add 478,000 households by 2035
 - Growth beyond caps must be minimized or offset
- State Workgroup Recommendations
 - ♦ Final Report out August 2013
 - Next state publishes proposed regulations
- If There Is Legislation, Uphill Battle At Committee Level
