- Midpoint Assessment Activities & Schedule
 - Low priorities identified that involve other work groups:
 - Explore evaluation of wastewater in the annual progress runs examining **current versus average flows** and to ensure increases due to growth are expected/acceptable– Milestones and WWT WGs
 - Bay TMDL and WIP/Milestones Policy, including **stability in allocations vs. model changes**, and consideration that **WWTPs have already upgraded** Ag WG, Other
 - Come up with way to account for trades TOWG and WWTWG
 - Evaluate how biosolids land applied and accounted for WWTWG, would require coordination w/ Ag WG
- WWTWG's priorities:
 - Improve data for **non-significant facilities**, especially industrials
 - Standardize methods to account for net loads from industrial facilities
 - Determine how to incorporate local septic data
 - Develop methods for identifying/quantifying loads from commercial and residential onsite systems
 - Agree on methods to account for reduced septic loads
- Workgroup input requested:
 - •BMP Verification (How much time should we spend on this?)
 - Report from the BMP Verification Review Panel meeting on December 6th.
 - Discuss and finalize the verification protocol.
 - Decision requested: Finalization of wastewater verification protocol for the consideration of the Verification Committee at its February meeting
