Recruitment and Completion Rates to Date

- As of November 28, 2018, there are 22,997 recruited households who completed the Part 1 survey
- As of November 28, 2018, there are 15,956 households who completed the travel diary (Part 2 survey)
- The conversion rate (% of recruited HHs who completed the survey) is 70%
- As of November 2, 2018, there were 122,172 trips and 44,530 vehicles recorded in the travel diary (Part 2 survey)

Hispanic/Latino Outreach Update

- Hispanic/Latino surveys were mailed to 7,500 households in census block groups with greater than 50% Hispanic/Latino population
- Despite targeted efforts to reach out to this group (e.g., Spanish survey instrument, website, toll-free line, and CASA staff), the response rate has been much lower than expected
- Will debrief with CASA staff after the survey to look at recommendations for future surveys



Looking Ahead: Survey Schedule

- Quarter 5 mailings for the main survey have been completed as of October 23, 2018
 - Additional letter drops for the Arlington County add-on to bring the number of completed households closer to the sample target of 578 households (currently 449 HHs)
- RTS data collection to conclude on December 31, 2018
- Post-survey processing (e.g., data cleaning, factoring, weighting) will begin January 2019 and continue through 2019 (FY 2020)
- Public release dataset anticipated in FY 2020
