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
Introduction

 - Married-couple family households
 - Male householder, no wife present, family households
 - Female householder, no husband present, family households
- Presentation will examine
 - Proportion of households that are comprised of families with children
 - Specific characteristics of children in DC and the DC Metro Region
 - Living Arrangements of Children
- 2012 ACS 1-year estimates

Household and Family Types

- Family consists of a householder plus other people living in the same household, related by birth, marriage, or adoption
- Family Households in DC Metro Region, 2012
 - 42.2% (112,493) of DC households (smallest percentage)
 - 65.5% (1,364,998) of DC Metro Region households
 - Largest Percent: Stafford County, VA with 82.5 percent (34,916)
 - Largest Number: Montgomery County, MD with 250,105 (69.3 percent)


Figure 1. Family vs Non-Family Households in the DC Metro Region, 2012



Family Households with Own Children

- Own Child A never-married child under 18 years who is a son or daughter by birth, a stepchild, or an adopted child of the householder.
- Family Households with Own Children, 2012
 - DC Metro Region: 656,600, 48.1 percent
 - Largest Percent: Loudoun County, VA with 59.5 percent (51,078)
 - Smallest Percent: Alexandria City, VA with 38.9 percent (12,559)
 - Largest Number: Fairfax County, VA with 138,084 (49.8 percent)
 - Smallest Number: Fauquier County, VA with 7,100 (43.7 percent)

Family Households by Type

Types of Families

- Married-Couple Family A family in which the householder and his or her spouse are listed as members of the same household.
- Male Householder, No Wife Present A family with a male householder and no spouse of householder present.
- Female Householder, No Husband Present A family with a female householder and no spouse of householder present.

Family Household Types with Own Children

- Married-couples with own children
 - Lowest percent: District of Columbia with 49.8 percent (23,187)
 - Highest percent: Fauquier County, VA with 84.9 percent (6,025)
- Male Householder, no wife present with own children
 - Lowest percent: Fauquier County, VA with 0.5 percent (36)
 - Highest percent: Prince George's County, MD with 10.1 percent (8,883)
- Female Householder, no husband present with own children
 - Lowest percent: Loudoun County, VA with 12.2 percent (6,247)
 - Highest percent: District of Columbia with 43.1 percent (20,051)

Figure 3. Family Types with own children under 18 years, DC Metro Region, 2012



 - With own children, highest Arlington County, VA: \$161,634
 - No children, highest Arlington County, VA: \$151,464
- Male householder, no wife Median Family Income
 - With own children, highest Loudon County, VA: \$89,515
 - No children, highest Stafford County, VA: \$114,111
- Female householder, no husband Median Family Income
 - With own children, highest Prince Williams County, VA: \$48,495
 - No children, highest Calvert County, MD: \$95,972

Figure 4. Median Family Income, District of Columbia and DC Metro Region, 2012



Selected Characteristics of Children Living in Family Households

- In 2012, 50.1 percent of the children living in married-couple family households in the District were under 6 years of age, compared to 34.7 percent regionally.
- In the District, 46.4 percent of children in married-couple family households were white, while 34.3% were black, compared to the DC Metro Region where 57.8 percent were white and 17.7 percent were black.
- In male householder, no wife present, family households in the District, 73.4 percent of children were black, while 15.2 percent were white. In female householder, no husband present, family households in the District, 85.0 percent of children black, while 7.8 percent were white.
- In 2012, Hispanic children of any race represented 15.5 percent of children in married-couple family households, 14.8 percent in male householder families, and 12.1 percent in female householder families.
- The largest percentage of children living in households receiving public assistance in the District can be found in female householder, no husband present, family households in 2012, where 66.8 percent of these households received assistance.
- An estimated 43.8 percent of children living in female household families were living in poverty in 2012, compared to 30.2 percent of these family types.
- The majority of children living in married-couple families in the District lived in owner-occupied housing (64.3 percent), compared to children of single parents (male householder 35.9 percent, female householder 21.5 percent) in 2012.
