

TPB Technical Committee Meeting Highlights

March 5, 2004

The Technical Committee met on Friday, March 5 at COG. Five items were reviewed for inclusion on the TPB agenda on March 17.

- TPB agenda Items 7 and 8

The Committee was briefed on the proposed changes to the current FY 2004 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) and the final draft FY 2005 UPWP (July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005). The Committee recommended that TPB approve the proposed amendment to the FY 2004 UPWP and the final FY 2005 UPWP.

- TPB agenda Item 9

The Committee was briefed on the final draft FY 2005 Commuter Connections Work Program (CCWP) (July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005). The Committee recommended that TPB approve the final FY 2003 CCWP.

- TPB agenda Item 11

The Committee reviewed the updated information on the project submissions for the air quality conformity analysis of the 2004 CLRP and the FY 2005-2010 TIP. The Committee recommended that the TPB Program Committee release the updated project submission information for public comment at the TPB Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) meeting on March 11 and extend the comment period to April 10.

- TPB agenda Item 12

The Committee was briefed on the draft scope of work for the air quality conformity assessment for the 2004 CLRP and the FY 2005-2010 TIP.

Two items were presented for information and discussion:

- The Committee reviewed a proposal for regular briefings to the Committee from local government staff on current transportation activities and projects underway in their jurisdictions. These briefings would then be candidates for presentation to the TPB. The first presentation was on the Richmond Highway Public Transportation Initiative underway in Fairfax County.
- Staff reviewed the status of the alternative land use scenarios for the Regional Mobility and Accessibility Study. The transportation subgroup met to identify transportation scenarios on March 2. The next meeting of the Joint Technical Working Group (JTWG) for this study is scheduled for March 12.
