- (1) Adjusted population figures for Maryland counties reflect net population after deduction of city populations within their boundaries. Virginia county and city populations are counted separately and thus do not have to be adjusted.
- (2) Regional Water Fund allocation formula for the Blue Plains Users (per Section 9 of the 1985 IMA, and codified under CBPC By-laws) is 80% of the RWF: District of Columbia (DC) (20%), Montgomery County (20%), Prince George's County (20%) and Fairfax County (20%). Remaining jurisdictions' share is 20% by adjusted populations for participating jurisdictions.

Note: DC-WASA pays for 100% of the District's share of the RWF. WSSC pays for 100% of Prince George's and Montgomery Counties' shares of the RWF, as well as 100% of the shares for five additional Maryland jurisdictions (i.e., Bowie, College Park, Gaithersburg, Greenbelt, and Takoma Park).

- (3) Regional Environmental Fund contributions are calculated on a prorata share of the region's population for participating jurisdictions.
