

MD MOTOR VEHICLE OCCUPANT FATALITY CONTRIBUTING FACTORS


Maryland's 2022 Observed SB Rate: 92.7%




REPORTED FATALITIES YEAR TO DATE IN 2022* (AS OF 11/2/2022)


REPORTED FATAL CRASHES YEAR TO DATE IN 2022 (AS OF 11/2/2022)
