Bulk/Brush Program Prior to Change

- Serviced with crane truck versus rear loader
- 5 bulk/brush pick-ups included in annual service
- Size limit 12 yards (minivan)
- Over 12 yards is considered a Mega Bulk minimum \$110 per load
- Additional yards charged \$5/yard; estimate based off supervisor inspection
- 4 6 trucks per day = approximately 200 tickets



Statement of Service 2019

Special Collections

Your base service includes five special collections per fiscal year (July 1 - June 30). You must schedule special collections in advance. **Deadline for scheduling next day pickup is 2:30 PM the day before your collection day.** Special collection piles are limited to:

- 12 cubic yards of material (a pile about 5 feet x 6 feet x 10 feet)
- Piles of heavy/dense materials are limited to 6 cubic yards.
- Any one item cannot be more than 6 feet long and 6 inches in diameter.
- Do not put debris under power wires or tree branches. We need 20 feet of clearance on all sides of debris pile as well as above the debris pile so that we can safely collect.

Megabulk: The Megabulk Program is designed to help customers remove cut up trees and large loads of waste from their properties - including construction and demolition waste. The minimum charge for a Megabulk collection is \$110, but prices will vary depending on the volume of material. Material must not be placed under power lines or tree limbs; we require 20 feet of clearance on all sides and above the pile. Waste may not be left at the curb for more than 10 days. You are responsible for removing the material within 10 days, either with the Megabulk Program, another contractor or by self-hauling the waste. Failure to do so may result in Fairfax County removing the materials at your risk and expense. The minimum cost for county removal of abandoned materials is \$250 plus actual labor, equipment and disposal costs.

Subject: Updated Terms of Service

Dear Sanitary District Resident:

As the Solid Waste Management Program (SWMP) continues to adapt to the evolving circumstances of the COVID-19 pandemic, our team of dedicated professionals remains committed to providing you with the best waste management services possible. Despite the many challenges related to worker and community safety, our collection crews have remained on the front lines, working to keep your neighborhoods clean. SWMP is committed to keeping its workers and our customers as safe as possible while we execute our vital public health mission. We ask for your patience and cooperation as we work to overcome the challenges facing our community, and together we can make Fairfax County a greener, safer, and better place to live.

Each year, SWMP provides our customers with a Statement of Service, as required of all waste collectors by County Code. This year's Statement is enclosed, and has a fresh new look intended to make this resource easier to use, and to highlight changes to our terms of service that reflect the "new normal" of COVID-19 and the changing economic and service challenges of modern waste collection in an urban setting.

One of the most significant changes is the way in which we will pick up extra trash. Specifically, SWMP will only collect materials that have been set out curbside in a County-issued cart (i.e., no loose materials in piles or stacked next to the cart). We are also adjusting our business process so that billing better reflects the scope of services being given. Effective immediately, the base level of service for our residential customers will consist of weekly collection of one 96-gallon trash cart, one 96-gallon recycling cart, and up to ten bags of yard waste. Yard waste should be placed in paper bags or reusable containers.

Customers who produce more trash than one cart can hold have several options, as follows:

- Recycle More we find that many customers are throwing away items that could be reused or recycled instead (e.g., clothing, toys, recyclable containers, and paper items).
- Throw Away Less a growing movement among County residents is to make purchasing choices that create less trash in the first place (e.g., avoiding single-serving packaging, buying in bulk).
- Self-Haul excess trash and recyclables can be delivered to either of the County's recycling and disposal centers at the I-95 Landfill in Lorton or the I-66 Transfer Station in Fairfax; and
- Purchase Extra Service- customers can arrange for additional carts and service the annual cost is \$120 per cart. Our Customer Service team can assist you in changing your level of service.

Also, customers who need to get rid of something bulky that cannot fit into a cart (e.g., old furniture, large household appliances) will receive up to five "special pick-ups" of these items each fiscal year.

September 30, 2020 Updated Terms of Service Page Two

Effective March 1, 2021, each special pick-up is limited to a maximum of two cubic yards of waste (this is about the size of four trash carts) and you will still need to schedule that special pick up on the county website or via our Customer Service team as you do currently. Customers who set out more than two cubic yards of bulky waste can request an estimate of the cost for collection and disposal, with the choice of having Fairfax County crews pick it up, or hiring another firm to remove the items. As with regular refuse and recycling, self-haul is also an option.

Keep in Mind

- For safety reasons, there must be a 20 ft. clearance on all sides of special collection materials
- Do not place items under utility wires or tree branches.
- Items must be less than 6 feet long.
- Set out items by 6 a.m. on the collection day.
- If materials are placed at a location other than the curb of your address (around the corner or across the street), include instructions in the comments field.
- The county is not responsible for items placed near the special pick-up pile.



Bulk/Brush Program After Change


- Serviced with combination of crane truck and rear loader
- Continue to provide 5 free bulk/brush pick-ups per year
- Size limit two yards (REL hopper = 3 yards)
- Discontinue "Mega Bulk" service
 - Charge for amounts over 2 yards
- Additional yards charged \$15/yard; estimate provided by customer
- 3 4 trucks per day = approximately 125 tickets


