Re: Preliminary Schedule for Round 9.0 Cooperative Forecast

The Draft Round 8.4 Cooperative Forecasts is scheduled to be adopted by the COG Board of Directors at their October 2015 meeting. It was the decision of the Planning Directors Technical Advisory Committee to start the process for developing a new Cooperative Forecasts in 2015. The Cooperative Forecasting and Data Subcommittee have begun reviewing regional econometric data to compare to the existing Round 8.4 Cooperative Forecasts. A final June 2015 data product is currently under review by the Cooperative Forecasting Committee. The schedule for Round 9.0 will be similar to Round 8.4 with an accelerated schedule to approve both the control totals and submit the TAZ level data in early 2016.

Round 9.0 TAZ level forecast are due to COG staff by February 1, 2016.

February 10th COG Board approves Round 9.0 as inputs for TPB's Air Quality Conformity Analysis.

Mid-February 2016

TAZ level forecasts are transmitted to Transportation Planning Staff.

March - September 2016

March – September – Modeling activity – Transportation Planning Staff.
