




 Invited speakers present a critical obstacle that needs collaboration and a near-term solution:

"Regarding Critical Infrastructure, to achieve DMV's climate, health & equity goals, a critical obstacle to collectively overcome in 12 months is

- Participants vote on which speaker has articulated the most urgent obstacle.
- Invited participants are strategically placed into breakout tables to compete on developing a 12-month solution to the selected obstacle.
- An AEG Task Force is formulated to carry out the selected 12-month solution.





DMV Stakeholders agree: **Mode shift** is key to regional mobility, equity, and climate goals. A clean transportation system for the DMV needs to move away from private vehicles in 2024.

Task Force efforts to address: Employer Rider Challenge

The idea: Use of gamification to incentivize people to take transit

Task Force Goals:

- Short-Term: Recruit area universities to execute "March Madness" student rider challenge
- Medium-Term: Work with area employers to implement a summer/fall commuter rider challenge

Benefits: Improve relationships with area universities and employers AND bring more riders to Metro and area transit
