 The MOVES Task Force was created in August 2009 to provide technical guidance on how to best use local input data for the MOVES model which is scheduled to replace MOBILE6.2 for conformity determinations in two years. The Committee will be briefed on the Task Force's recommended input development and technical methodologies for MOVES2010a, and on preliminary findings of sensitivity tests that compare emissions inventories calculated using MOVES2010a to those calculated using Mobile6.2.
