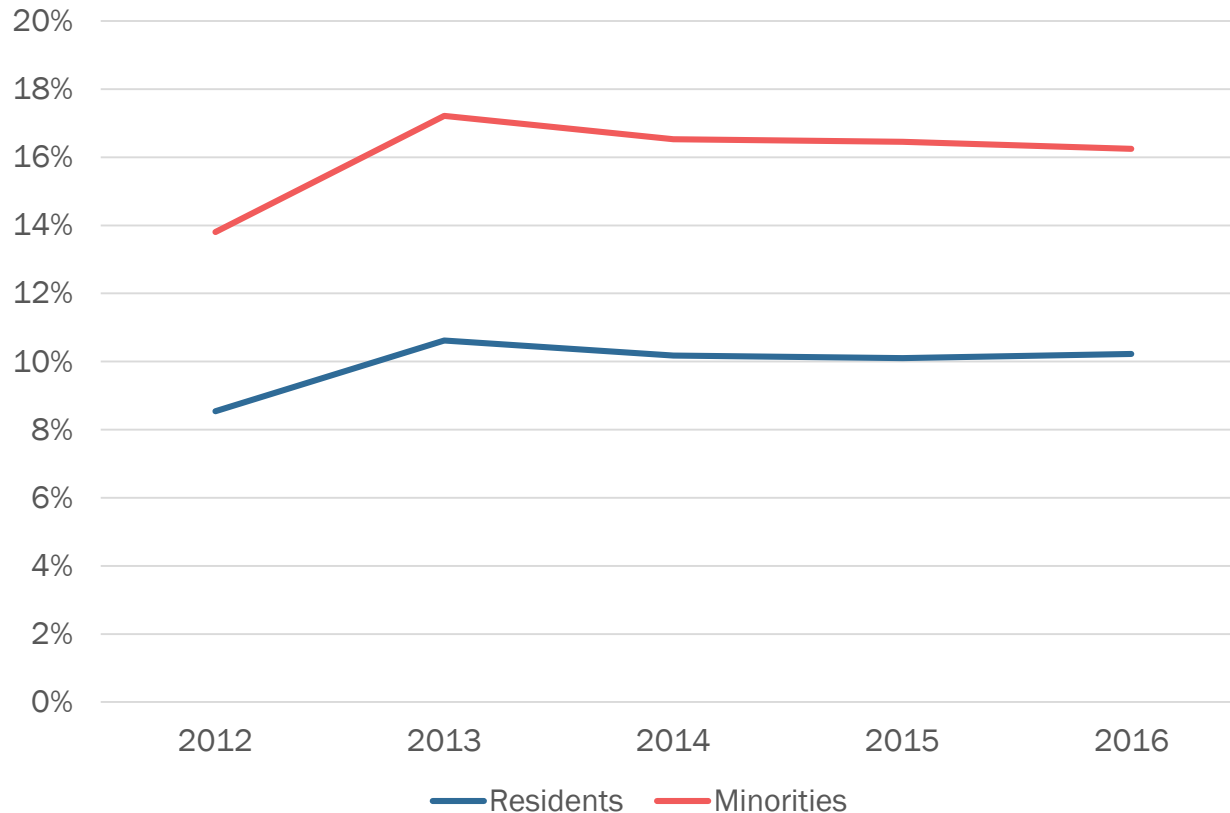

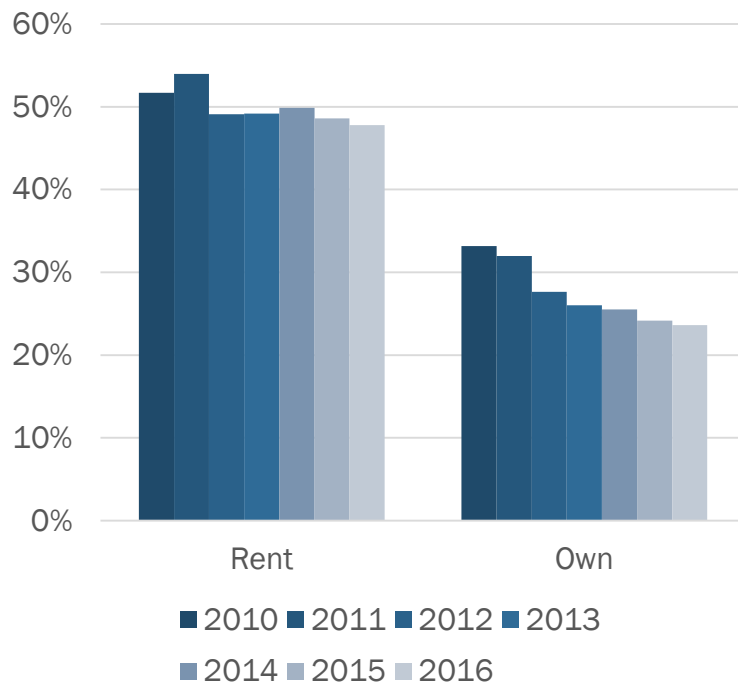


Reduce % of renters and homeowners who are housing cost-burdened



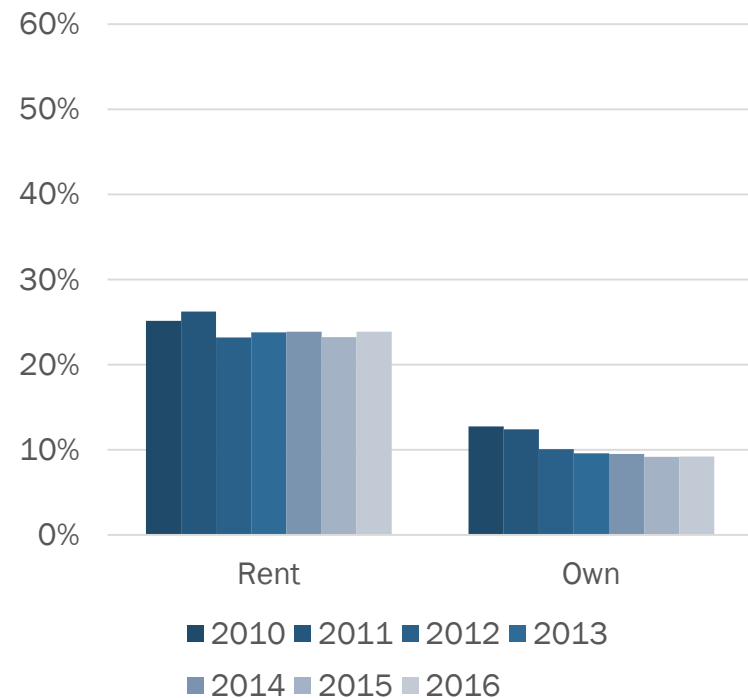
Cost Burdened:

50%+ monthly income to housing



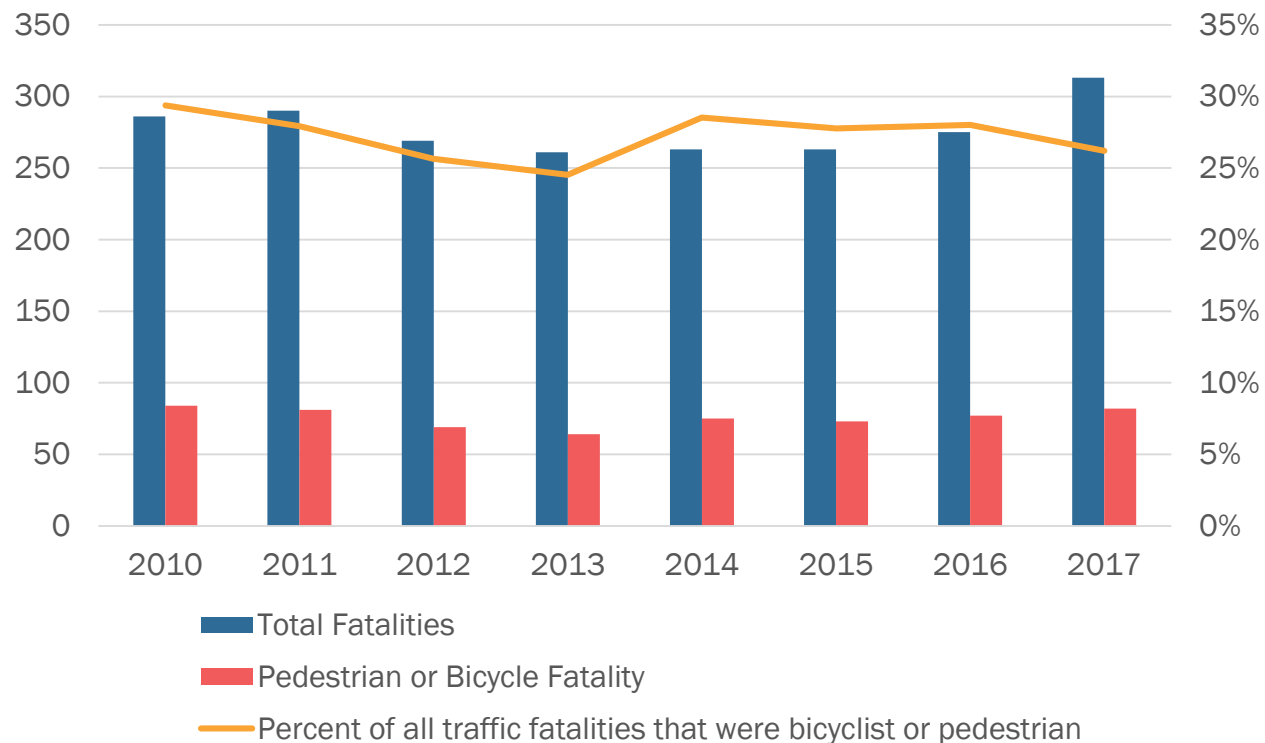

Reduce the number of pedestrian and bicycle fatalities



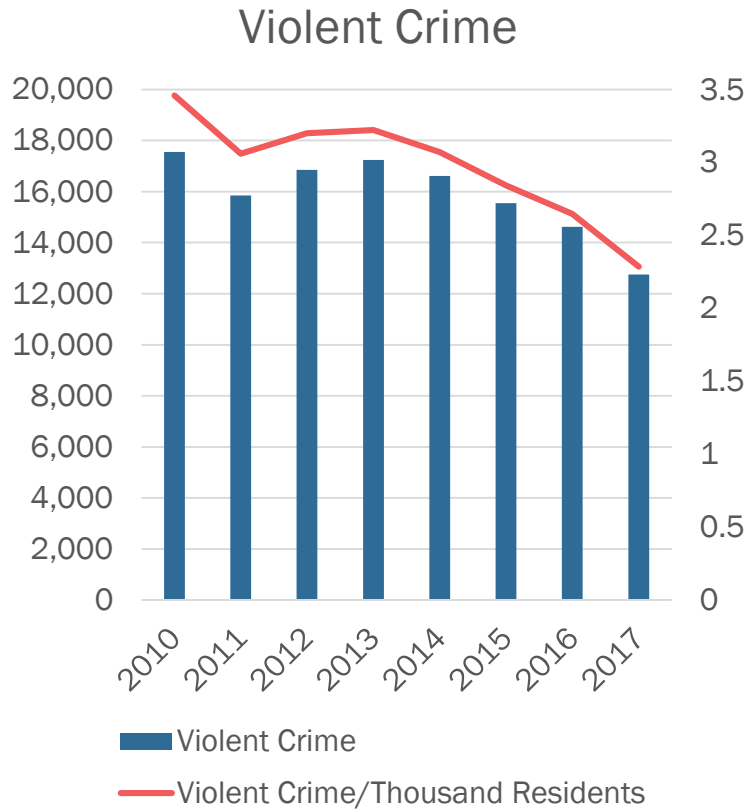
Traffic Fatalities

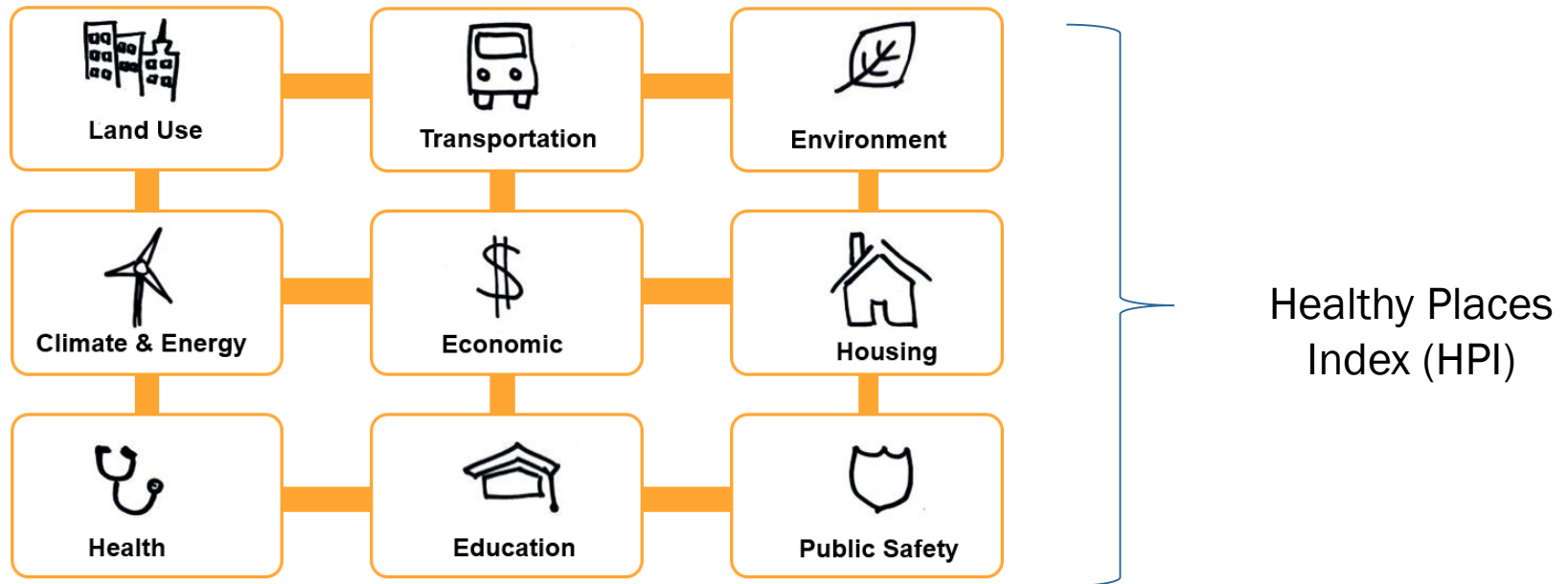
Improving Quality & Duration of Lives
