

- Communities in which every person enjoys health and well-being.






Reduce percent of residents living in High-Poverty Census Tracts




Reduce % of renters and homeowners kine who are housing cost-burdened






Percent of all traffic fatalities that were bicyclist or pedestrian




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Improving Quality & Duration of Lives
