Relay in Operation

- Autonomous vehicle with safety steward onboard
- Easymile EZ10 Gen3 vehicle
- Route operates between Dunn Loring Metro and Mosaic District
- Runs Monday Thursday 10 am to 2 pm
- FCDOT provides operational oversight of Relay, including operations contract with Transdev







Fire and Police **Training**

• Easymile and Transdev held training sessions with FCDOT and local fire and police departments to respond to incidents involving Relay

Safety Steward Training

- Extensive training and evaluation of safety steward
- Safety steward always onboard to ensure a safe operation



Impacts due to COVID-19

- Reduction in foot traffic at Mosaic and ridership from Dunn Loring Metro
- COVID-19 policies:
 - Increased cleaning
 - Mask mandate
 - Limit on passenger capacity
