Introduction

The RTDC was developed to improve access and data sharing between TPB member, jurisdictional partners, as well as other interested parties.

Staff at the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board (TPB) has collected transportation data from various sources, primarily member jurisdictions, state agencies, and transit authorities. These data are packaged into the Regional Transportation Data Clearinghouse (RTDC).

Datasets in the RTDC represent various transportation modes (highway, transit, bicycle, aviation). Current 'core' RTDC datasets such as traffic and transit counts are routinely updated as new data become available

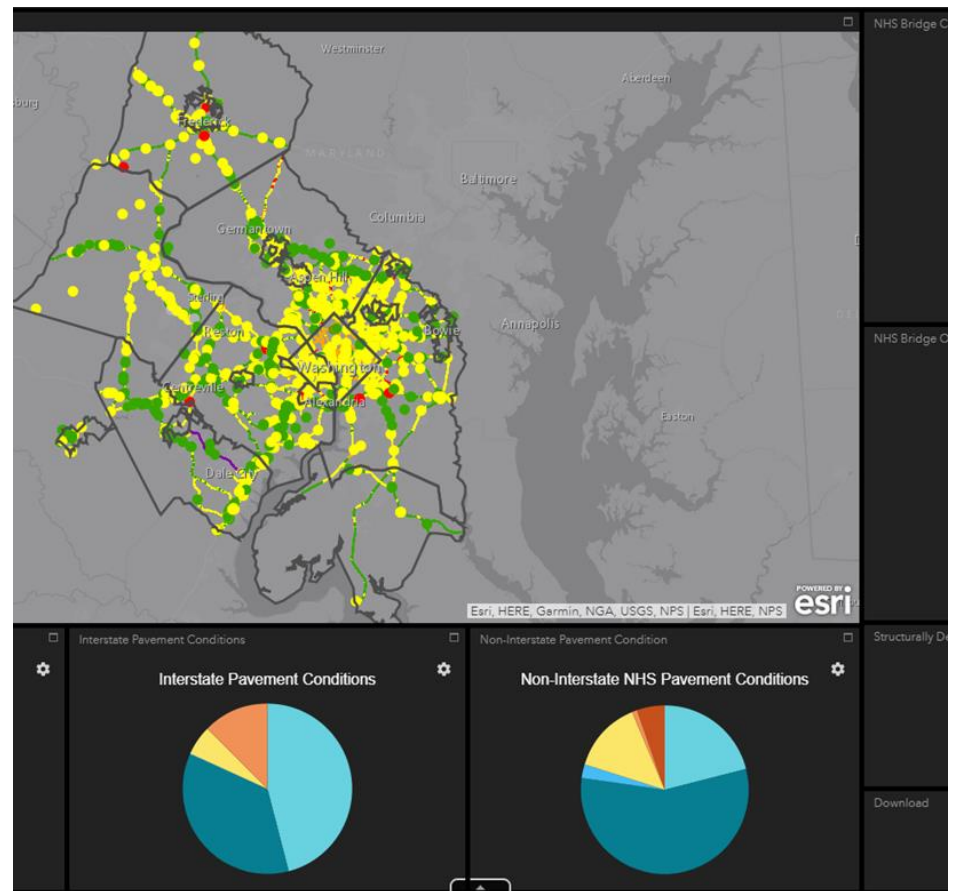
