*Jim Larsen, Bureau Chief, Arlington County Commuter Services*

*Arlington has developed a 9-month [demonstration project](#) to provide structure to the operation and use of Shared Mobility Devices (SMDs) within the County and to evaluate their impacts. SMDs are considered to be pedal bikes, electric-assist bikes (e-bikes), and electric-assist scooters (e-scooters) that do not require a station, as is required by the County’s station-based [Capital Bikeshare](#) service.*

*The County Board approved this demonstration project at its Sept. 25, 2018, meeting. Interested SMD operators must submit a permit application and Memorandum of Agreement to be considered for the pilot program. The pilot is beginning in early October 2018.*
