

Policies to Drive Zero Waste



- Styrofoam: 2006 & 2016 Food Service Waste Reduction Ordinance:
 Requires restaurants and food vendors to not use styrofoam food service ware and instead use food ware that is recyclable or compostable
- Single use bags: 2007, 2012 & 2019 Plastic Bag Reduction Ordinance:
 Requires the use of compostable plastic, recyclable paper and/or reusable checkout bags
 10 cent 25 cent charge
- Straws, Utensils &Foodware: 2018 Single-Use Food Ware Plastics, Toxics & Litter Reduction Ordinance: Single use plastic straws available upon request Requires that food service ware accessories be provided only on request or at self-service stations Prohibits the sale or use of single-use food service ware made with fluorinated chemicals
- 2014 Bottled Water Ordinance:
 Restricts the sale or distribution on City property of drinking water in plastic bottles of 21 ounces or less
 Bar the use of City funds to purchase bottled water
- 2011 **Yellow Pages**: Opt-in

Mandatory Recycling & Composting Ordinance



Requirements for Businesses

Property owners/managers must provide:

- Color-coded, labeled bins in convenient locations:
 Blue for recycling, Green for composting, and black for trash
- Education on what goes in each bin must be provided to tenants, employees, contractors, and janitors

Food vendors that provide disposable food service ware or to-go containers must:

- Provide color-coded, labeled bins for use by customers and visitors
- Place bins near a main exit






