 - Update elements definitions, resources, data sources

 - Conduct a review of new EJ resources, materials, and best practices
 - Identify topics relevant to CEEPC and MWAQC
 - Identify how EJ is currently being addressed in decision making

 - Update development:
 - Develop an outline for the EJ toolkit and educational plan for COG staff, BEEAC, MWAQC TAC review and input
 - Work with COG staff to develop toolkit update and education materials
 - Present draft update and educational materials
 - Present to MWAQC and CEEPC for review
 - Work with ACPAC staff to present the update and enhance the EJ knowledge and capacity of MWAQC, MWAQC-TAC, CEEPC and BEEAC members and COG staff
