


2008 Foster Care Annual Report

Executive Summary:

Each year the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (COG) queries local child welfare systems to collect data, analyze findings and discover trends occurring in area foster care systems throughout the metropolitan Washington region. Within this 2008 report you will find data, analysis & notes of trends in the following areas: number of children in foster care, placements, foster care providers, dollar amount variance of reimbursement rates, number of children awaiting adoption and the number of adoptions. Below is a summary of regional outcomes in these areas.



Children In Foster Care: (page 2)

The number of children in foster care **decreased by .5%** as compared to 2007. (This regional statistic excludes Loudoun county, as they did not report data to COG in 2007.)



Placements: (page 3)

The region used **6.9% fewer group homes and .4% more family-like foster homes** in 2008 as compared to 2007. (This regional statistic excludes Loudoun county, as they did not report data to COG in 2007.)



Foster Care Providers: (page 4)

In 2008 the region retained fewer foster families than in 2007. Specifically there was a 2.6% decrease in homes approved by the end of 2008. (This regional statistic excludes Loudoun county, as they did not report data to COG in 2007.)



Foster Care Reimbursement Rates: (page 5)

The District of Columbia offers the largest reimbursement rate for foster care providers at all levels, compared to other jurisdictions in the Washington region.



Children Waiting to be Adopted: (page 6)

Overall, the number of children waiting to be adopted throughout the region **decreased by 7%**. (This regional statistic excludes Loudoun county, as they did not report data to COG in 2007.)



Adoptions: (page 7)


Overall, The number of child adoptions throughout the region **decreased by .4%** from 2007 to 2008. (This regional statistic excludes Loudoun county, as they did not report data to COG in 2007.)

NOTE: With the exception of the cities of Manassas and Manassas Park, all other COG members, cities and towns, receive services through their neighboring counties; hence, their data is included in the county's report. For instance:

- Fairfax County serves the City of Falls Church & the City of Fairfax.

- Montgomery County serves the City of Rockville, City of Gaithersburg and City of Takoma Park.
- Prince George's County serves the Town of Bladensburg, City of Bowie, City of College Park & City of Greenbelt.
- Frederick County serves the City of Frederick.




