RESOLUTION ON AMENDMENTS TO

THE FY 2004-2009 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP)
THAT ARE EXEMPT FROM THE AIR QUALITY CONFORMITY REQUIREMENT
TO INCLUDE OR MODIFY FUNDING FOR NINE HIGHWAY PROJECTS, FOUR
TRANSIT PROJECTS, FOUR TRANSPORTATION EMISSION REDUCTION
MEASURE(TERM) PROJECTS, AND ONE ITS PROJECT AS REQUESTED BY
THE VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (VDOT)

WHEREAS, the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board (TPB), which is the metropolitan planning organization (MPO) for the Washington Region, has the responsibility under the provisions of the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century (TEA-21) for developing and carrying out a continuing, cooperative and comprehensive transportation planning process for the Metropolitan Area; and

WHEREAS, on December 17, 2003 the TPB adopted the 2003 Constrained Long-Range Transportation Plan (CLRP) and the FY 2004-2009 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and

WHEREAS, in the attached letter of March 29, 2004, VDOT, on behalf of Loudoun County, the Town of Leesburg, and itself, has requested amendments to the FY 2004-2009 TIP to include or modify funding for nine highway projects, four transit projects, four transportation emissions reduction measure(TERM) projects, and one ITS project, as described in the attached materials; and

WHEREAS, these projects and funding changes are exempt from the air quality conformity requirement, as defined in Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regulations "40 CFR Parts 51 and 93 Transportation Conformity Rule Amendments: Flexibility and Streamlining; Final Rule," issued in the August 15, 1997 *Federal Register*;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Program Committee of the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board amends the FY 2004-2009 TIP to include or modify funding for nine highway projects, four transit projects, four TERM projects, and one ITS project, as described in the attached materials.

Dear Chairman Zimmerman:

On behalf of Loudoun County (copy attached), the Town of Leesburg (copy attached), and itself; the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) requests an amendment (copy attached) to the FY 2004-2009 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).

Also attached are CLRP and TIP description sheets for those projects requiring the development of this documentation. In addition, we have attached a table (Table 1) that describes the individual projects included in the TIP amendment, including the reason(s) each project is included in this request, conformity status, and funding implications.

In summary, this amendment requests the following:

Loudoun County - deallocation of funding from one road construction project in the TIP and reallocation of that funding to an existing project and to a new road construction project. The deallocation / reallocation does not affect air quality conformity since the projects are still expected to be open to traffic within their previously identified timeframes. In short, these changes will not affect the conformity modeling networks.

Town of Leesburg -deallocation of funding from one completed, road construction project (excess funds) and reallocation to two traffic signal timing coordination projects. These projects were included in the input used to develop the conformity analysis performed for the FY-04 TIP.

VDOT - allocation of FY-04 CMAQ and RSTP funding, per the NVTA's distribution, to two existing and one new road construction project, four existing TERMs, one new ITS project, one Metro canopy project, acquisition of buses for WMATA, two studies for new park-and-ride lots; and the reallocation of funding from the construction phase to the R/W phase for an existing road construction project. None of these projects will adversely affect the conformity analysis performed for the FY-04 TIP.

VDOT requests that this amendment be approved by the TPB Program Committee at its meeting on April 2, 2004.



Dear Mr Darley:

Loudoun County wishes to reallocate monies from three RSTP projects to similar projects in order to enable construction at an earlier date. This includes shifting \$693,000 from widening Route 606 between Route 621 and the Dulles Greenway allocated in FY 03, and \$900,000 from constructing Pacific Boulevard between Sterling Boulevard and Cedar Green Road allocated in FY 04 towards constructing the portion of Pacific Boulevard between Route 625 and Severn Way. This will take advantage of an activated Clark-Shirley firm currently constructing improvements in the vicinity. This will enable a portion of Pacific Boulevard needed to address the closure of the Commercial Drive intersection with Route 28 to come on line as quickly as possible.

In addition, we are requesting that flexibility be allowed to transfer some RSTP funds as needed from the implementation of the Route 7 Limited Access Plan (from years FY 02 and FY 03) towards final design and construction of the widening of Route 7/Route 15 Bypass between Route 9 and Route 15. As part of the federal omnibus spending bill approved on February 20, 2003, \$2,188,000 was allocated for the Route 7 Limited Access Plan. The estimated design for this road segment is estimated to be \$2.4 million. This is in addition to the \$1.2 million already allocated from FY 02 and FY 03. Because preliminary design work has already begun for the widening of the Route7/Route15 Bypass east of Route 15, the flexibility to utilize some funds from the Route 7 Limited Access Plan will enable this widening to move forward more quickly.



Please see that the currently approved TIP is amended to reflect use of this funding towards construction of these improvements.



Dear Chairman Klinge:

I am requesting reallocation of a total amount of \$317,560.00 from the East Market Street Widening Project U000-253-VO8, C501, UPC 14647: \$200,000 to an improvement project in the town to coordinate signals at various locations, Project, U000-253-111, C501, UPC 17688 and; \$117,560 to an improvement project to coordinate 7 traffic signals within the town, Project, U015-253-102, C501, UPC 50008. Sufficient funds in the East Market Street Widening Project are available to complete construction.

Funds in the total amount of \$284,000.00 were earmarked for the improvement projects to coordinate signals at various locations in the town as mentioned above: \$100,000 from CMAQ, \$140,000 from STP and \$44,000 from Town funds.

On January 9, 2004 the town opened the only bid received to coordinate signals in various locations in town, the "Advanced Traffic Signal Management System Project", (from Brothers Signal Company) in the amount of \$481,248.00. The anticipated total project cost that includes 15% for inspections and 10% contingencies is approximately \$601,560.00. The difference between the funded amount and the anticipated total project cost of \$317,560.00 was due to old estimates.

RSTP funds in the amount of \$3,574,000.00 are currently available in the East Market Street Widening Project, U000-253-V08, C501, UPC 14647. Please see Attachment A.

Therefore, I am requesting reallocation a total of \$317,560.00 from the East Market Street Widening Project to the projects to coordinate traffic signals in town as described above.
