Meeting Notes from the October 21, 2008 meeting

AGENDA ITEM 1 - INTRODUCTIONS

The meeting began with self-introductions of those in attendance. (See attached list)

AGENDA ITEM 2 - REVIEW OF PREVIOUS MEETING (7/15/08) NOTES

The group reviewed and approved the meeting notes as written.

AGENDA ITEM 3 INSTALLATION OF NEW CHAIRPERSON

Anna McLaughlin of DDOT became chair of the committee, replacing Mark Sofman of Montgomery County Commuter Services. A plaque was given to Mr. Sofman in recognition of his service to the committee.

AGENDA ITEM 4 - FY 2008 AND 2009 CONFORMITY REPORTS

Staff distributed the final conformity statement for FY2008 and the first quarter FY09 conformity statement.

AGENDA ITEM 5 - COMMUTING BY BLISS BUS

Amber Wasson of Bliss presented a new commuting option coming to the Metropolitan region, the Bliss bus. The anticipated kickoff for this service is January of 2009. Ms. Cynthia Fondriest asked if the pre-tax transit benefit would work with the service to which Ms. Wasson responded that they were looking into the matter.

AGENDA ITEM 6 – EMPLOYER RECOGNITION AWARDS

Douglas Franklin of COG presented information on proposed changes to the Employer Recognition Awards event. Applications for the event are scheduled to be sent to employers in December and the deadline for submission is in early February. Ms. Fondriest mentioned that the Association for Commuter Transportation is currently reviewing its awards as well. One of the proposed changes would be to have the sales team award not be a part of the event. Ms. Fondriest stated her preference to keep the award as part of the event as did several others on the committee. Christopher Napolitano of Joint Venture suggested that the invitations be altered to show a "presidential" type of insignia and have a well-known guest host the event. Nicholas Ramfos of COG stated that due to budgetary matters such an idea isn't very feasible given the size of funds available. Glenn Hiner of Fairfax DOT suggested that the monies spent be reallocated towards getting the word out with greater emphasis. The venue for the event, the National Press Club, is also being reconsidered for other sites. The committee wanted to review the information further and asked that Mr. Franklin forward it to them for the next meeting in January.
