On July 13, 2020, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) proposed to retain the primary and secondary ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS). The standards, established in 2015, are currently set at 70 parts per billion (ppb). Staff will brief the committee on the proposal and review a comment letter for MWAQC's approval.
