- n Regional Helicopter System Plan, 2005




# Regional Helicopter System Plan, 2005

#### n Goals

- Ensure that the current helicopter system meets the region's transportation and public services needs
- Manage the system better to help reduce community noise impacts
- Establish land use and permitting guidelines for helistops/heliports
- Document relationship between transportation and public service benefits of helicopter operations and economic well being of region

- n In 2002 48 active heliports in region
  - n Private/Corp -- 12
  - n Government -- 10
  - n Military -- 3
  - n Medical -- 22
  - n Public-Use -- 1




#### Forecast of Future Activity

- n Rotocraft manufactures and new models




#### Forecasts of Total Based Helicopters in Metropolitan Washington





#### Forecast of Total Helicopter Operations in Metropolitan Washington






#### Helicopter Operator and Market Needs

- n Establish a permanent helicopter working group
- Create a centralized and formal system to address helicopter noise complaints
- n Establish a program to support helicopter operator and market needs and to address zoning issues.




