Federal Requirements

Title VI: Civil Rights Act of 1964

Prohibit discrimination based on race, color, or national origin under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance




Environmental Justice

Executive Order 12898 (1994): Recipients of Federal funds must identify and avoid disproportionately high and adverse effects on minority and low-income populations



TPB Compliance with Title VI and EJ





What is the EJ Analysis?

 Examine the CLRP for any disproportionately high and adverse impacts on low-income and minority populations

The finding are used to:

- Ensure compliance
- Inform the regional planning process about transportation needs of low-income and minority populations
- Potentially assist in local community planning initiatives



Current and Proposed Approach to EJ Analysis

Current Approach

- Typical and compliant
- Impacts analyzed at regional scale
- Identified areas with changes in accessibility
- Compared low-income and minority populations impacted by changes to the general population

Proposed Approach


- Impacts analyzed on a smaller geographic scale
- Identify areas with higher than average concentration of low-income and minority populations ("Communities of Concern")
- Determine change in accessibility and compare changes between Communities of Concern and the rest of the region



What are the "Communities of Concern?


Small geographic areas with a higher than average concentration of low-Income and/or minority populations

- Identified by TPB Staff
- In consultation with the local jurisdictions'
 Planning Directors
- Used latest US Census data at the tract-level





Demographic Profile of the Region





"Communities of Concern" Methodology

- Used U.S. Census 2010-2014 American Community Survey data:
 - Identified the largest racial and ethnic groups that constitutes the minority population: (African-American, Asian, Hispanic/Latino)
 - Defined thresholds to determine low-income population
 - Calculated regional averages for low-income and minority population groups:
- Examined each U.S. Census tract in the region:
 - Calculated tract-level averages of low-income and minority populations
 - Determined if low-income and minority populations were higher than
 1.5 times the regional average and calculated a Ratio of Concentration
 - Assigned an index score to each of the 4 population groups in a tract;
 - Score for low-income population was doubled
 - Summed the index scores for a total score
- High-scoring tracts designated as Communities of Concern




Scoring Example: Census Tract 8038.01

(in Prince George's County, MD)






Proposed Communities of Concern
