Washington Regional Electric Vehicle WORK GROUP 2013

Purpose

The purpose of the **Washington Regional EV (WREV) Work Group** is to effectively support electric vehicle readiness, collaborating with area stakeholders and other interested parties in order to advance the deployment of electric vehicles (EVs) and EV charging infrastructure in the Washington region, where appropriate. The work group will provide a reliable framework for multi-stakeholder engagement and the discussion of new developments in the EV industry.

WREV Composition/Membership and Structure

The WREV work group's core membership is comprised of a cross section of COG's local government jurisdictions, the Greater Washington Regional Clean Cities Coalition, the Transportation and Climate Initiative (TCI) via Georgetown Climate Center, and the Baltimore-Washington Electric Vehicle Initiative (BEVI). Other adjunct stakeholders include the Electric Vehicle Association of Greater Washington, DC, area EVSE providers, academia, and state government assemblies such as the Maryland Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Council.

Leadership

The work group will be led by a Chair and Co-chair. The Chair and Co-chair positions will be held by one COG member jurisdiction from Maryland, Virginia or the District of Columbia and one private industry representative. The Chair and co-chair will be selected by nominations made by members of the work group. The positions are a year long term, to be reevaluated at the 1-year anniversary of the chairmanship.

Function and Operation

The work group will function as a forum for the discussion and coordination of public and private strategies to support EV deployment. In addition to maintaining work group dynamics as a clearinghouse for information sharing, discussion of relevant issues and exploration of topics, the work group will operate with tangible goals and objectives as identified by its members.
