2012 Grant Program

- \$214,500 MEA allocated
- \$212,968.66 used
- 36 Upgrades completed
- 11 EA but not Qualified (home needed repairs)
- All Municipals included
- \$40 average monthly Energy Savings
- \$500 average reduction in costs annually

2013 Grant Program

- \$400,000 MEA allocated
- \$115,000 Community Legacy (for home repairs to qualify)
- All Municipals included
- Encumbered \$240,000+
- 81 homes EA performed and evaluated
- 12 homes identified for CL involvement to upgrade and revitalize.(will result in \$100k CL and \$70k MEA funds)
- Better payback percentage 2013


