- Listening Session 3: 1 CoC administrator, system leader or cross sector partners per CoC

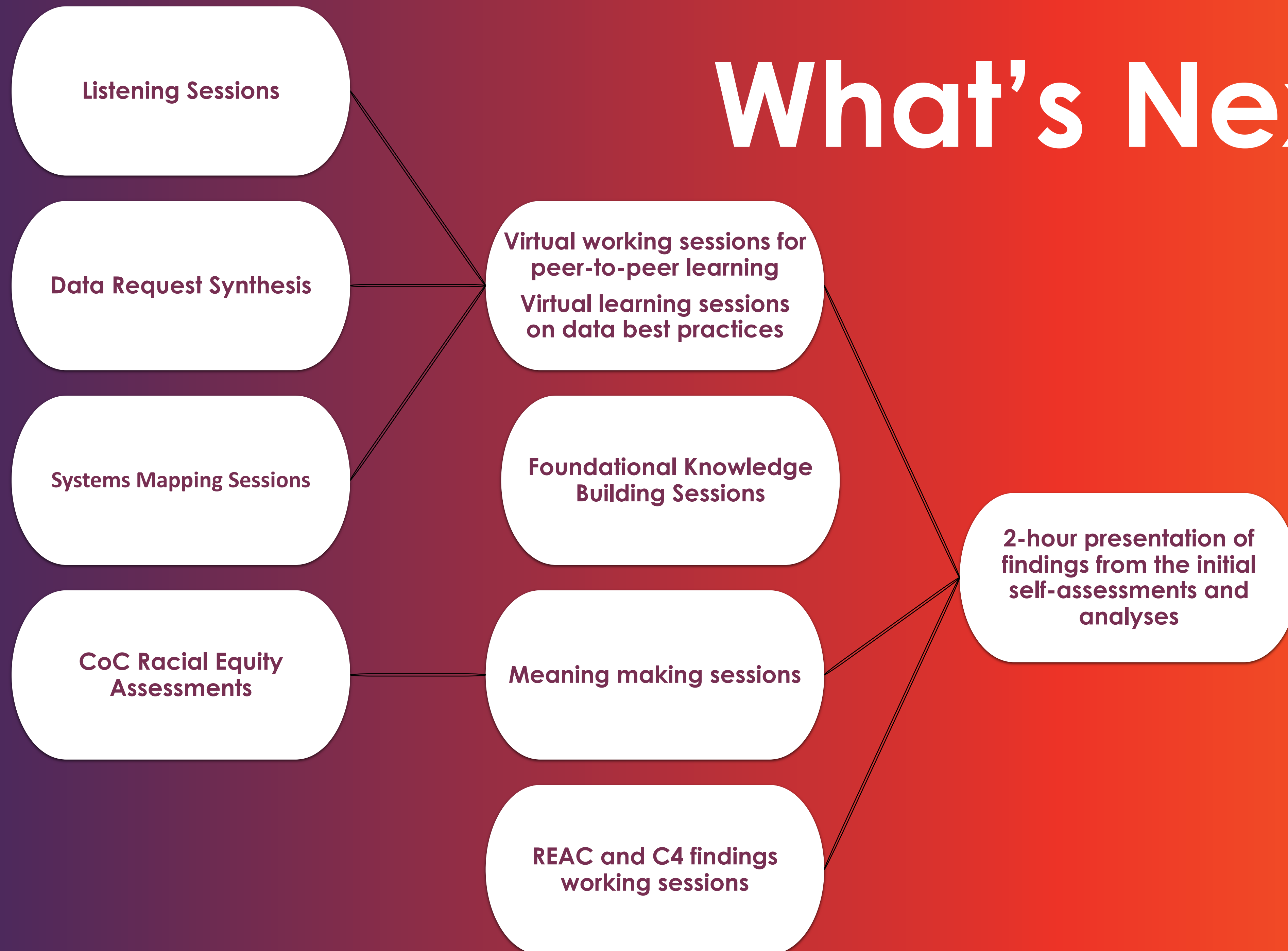
Regional Stakeholders
