**RESOLUTION TO ENTER A CONTRACT WITH THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA
DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH ENTITLED: "THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA'S TOTAL
MAXIMUM DAILY LOAD (TMDL) COORDINATION SUPPORT"**

WHEREAS, the 1972 Clean Water Act requires states to prepare "Total Maximum Daily Loads" or TMDLs for waterbodies listed as impaired; and

WHEREAS, the District of Columbia Department of Health, Environmental Health Administration (DC-DOH/EHA) is responsible for the preparation of TMDLs in the District of Columbia; and

WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (COG) has provided TMDL coordination support to DC-DOH/EHA in the past; and

WHEREAS, DC-DOH/EHA is desirous of continuing COG's supporting role.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
METROPOLITAN WASHINGTON COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS THAT:**

The Executive Director, or his designee, on behalf of COG, is authorized to enter into a contract with the District of Columbia's Department of Health to provide TMDL coordination support. The amount of the contract is for \$40,000. Work is to be completed no later than September 26, 2003. No additional local COG funds are required.
