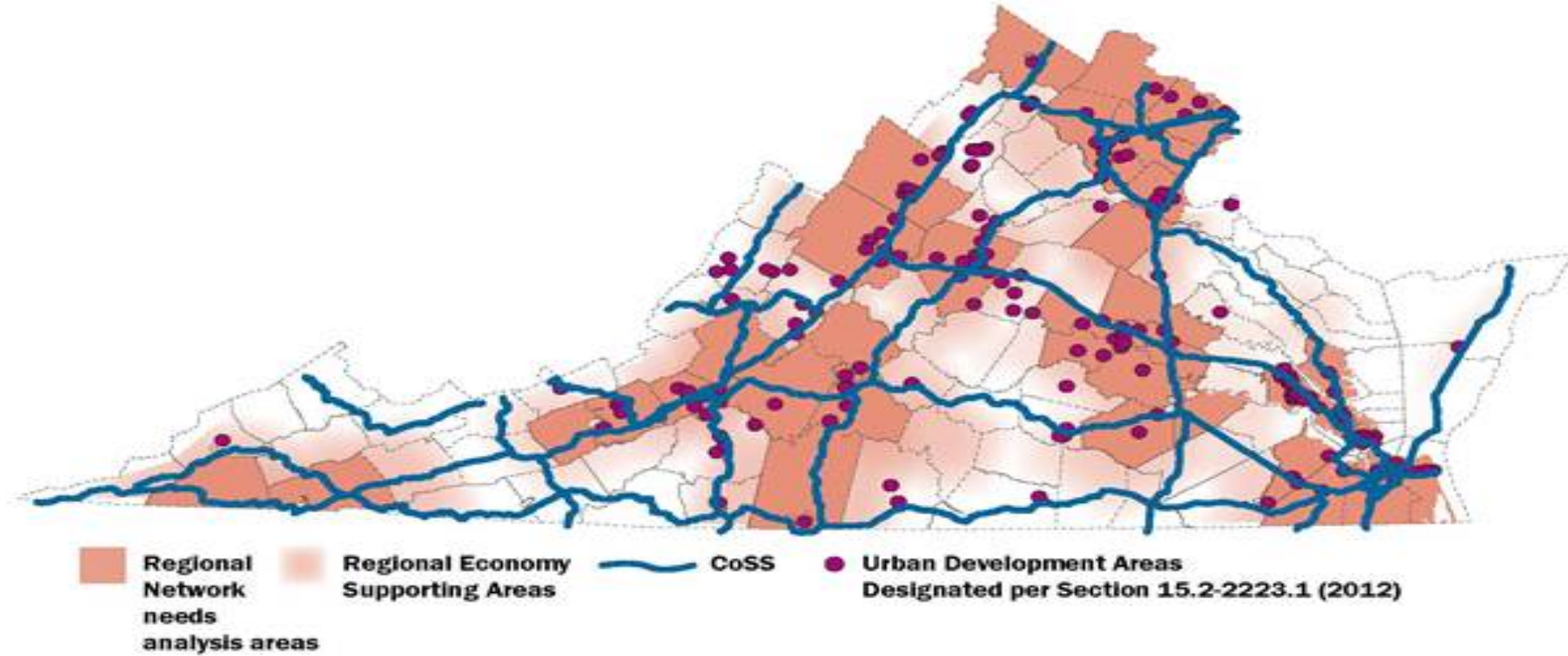

# SMART SCALE is about investing limited tax dollars in the right projects that meet the most critical transportation needs

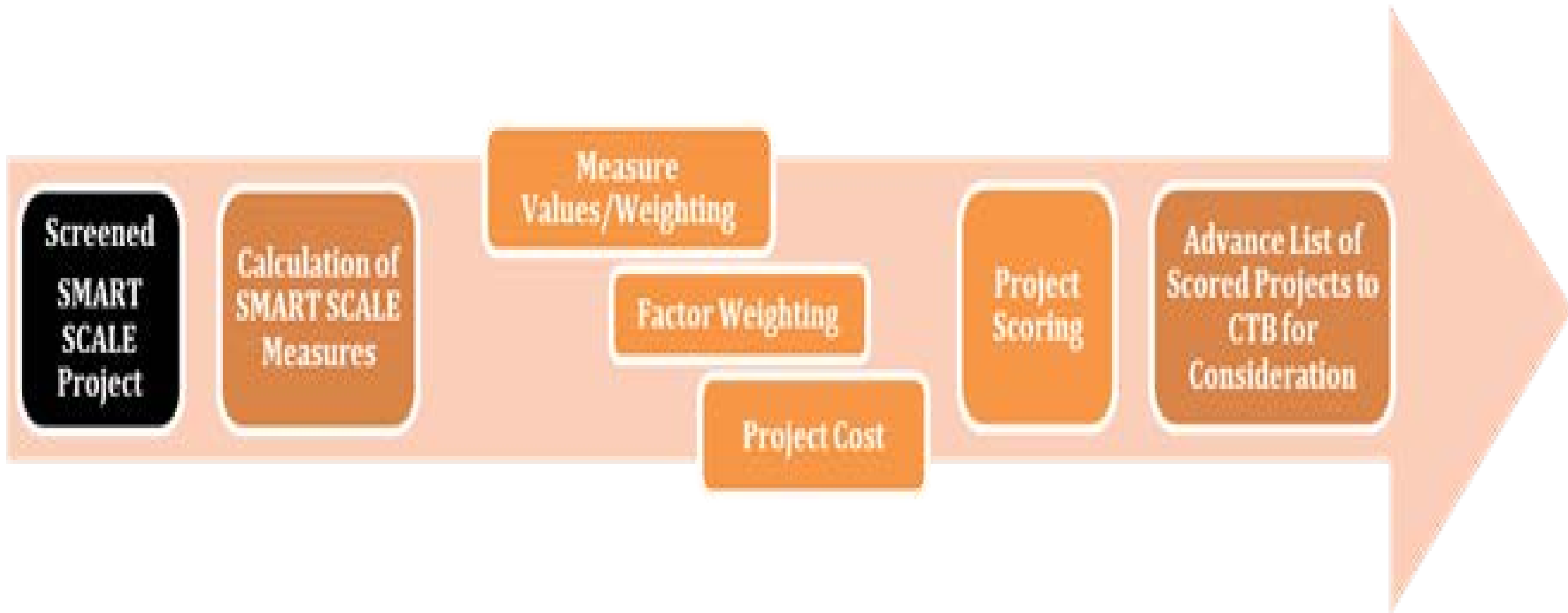


- **SMART SCALE** was established by Virginia General Assembly in 2014.
- **Process used to prioritize projects for Virginia's Six Year Program (SYIP)**
- **Number of applications evaluated (statewide):**
  - **FY 17 – 287 applications**
  - **FY 18 – 404 applications**
- **Total \$ Funded NoVA Projects NoVA funding \$**

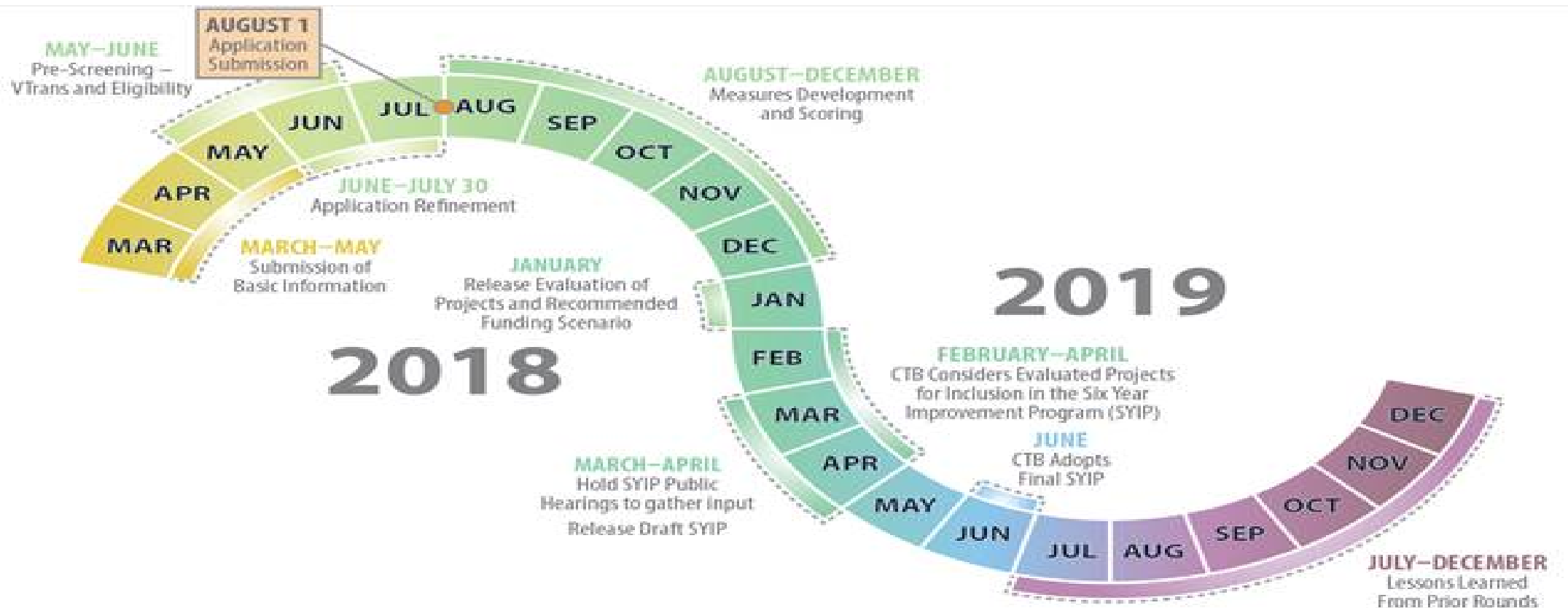
• <b>FY 17 - \$1.42 B</b>	<b>18</b>	<b>\$222.9 M</b>
• <b>FY 18 - \$ 1.03 B</b>	<b>21</b>	<b>\$367.3 M</b>
• <b>FY 20 – Approx. 800M</b>		
	• 50% Statewide Competition / 50% District Competition	
- **Final application due date August 1, 2018.**
- **New funding will be added to FY 24 and FY 25 in the FY 2020-2025 Six Year Program**

# Smart Scale Uses Objective Quantitative Performance Scoring to Allocate Transportation Funding

Factor	Congestion Mitigation	Economic Development	Accessibility	Safety	Environmental Quality	Land Use
(Category A-Large Urban Districts)	45 percent	5 percent	15 percent	5 percent	10 percent	20 percent



# The process takes about 16 months



# MPO Resolution of Support from MPO Policy Board

- Required for projects that are not already in an adopted Metropolitan Transportation Plan (CLRP).
- Pre-application portal closes June 8
- After June 8, VDOT will provide TPB with a list of projects that are eligible to file full applications.
- Funding being awarded for FY 24 and FY 25
- Projects that are NOT in the most recent adopted CLRP (2016) will require a resolution of support to continue the final application process.
