Purpose

The purpose of the Strategic Plan is to provide the framework and guidance for the National Capital Region's homeland security efforts (programming, budgeting, and execution)

The Strategic Plan was finalized and implemented in September of 2006

Composition

- 4 Goals
- 12 Objectives Supporting the Goals
- 30 Initiatives to Accomplish the Objectives
- Numerous Projects and Milestones to Support Each Initiative

The Strategic Plan includes a recommendation for a periodic update and review of Plan content every 3 years



Methodology

- Project and Milestone progress used to track overall initiative progress
- Totality of initiative progress used to measure objective and goal progress

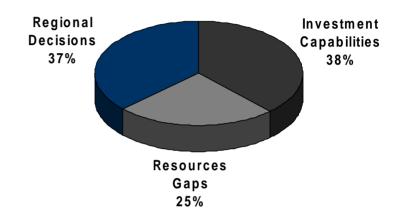




Goal 1: Planning & Decision Making

- Strengthen the regional approach to homeland security planning and decision-making
 - ■Strategic Plan update 40% complete
 - ■Regional planning process 82% complete
- Establish an NCR-wide process to identify and close gaps using public and private resources
 - ■Risk Assessment 81% complete
 - ■Requirements generation and prioritization. 25% complete (HIRA)
- Enhance oversight and accountability for the management of investments and capabilities
 - ■Regional oversight and accountability 85% complete
 - ■Investment lifecycle planning 38% complete

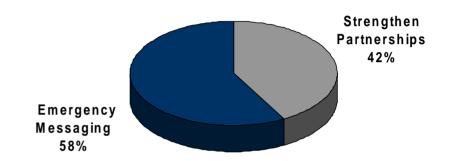




Goal 2: Community Engagement

- Increase public preparedness and emergency messaging before, during and after emergencies
 - ■Emergency information distribution 89% complete
 - ■Preparedness education campaigns 44% complete
- Strengthen partnerships among the NCR's public, civic, private, and NGO stakeholders
 - ■Public disaster preparedness 33% complete
 - ■Increase civic involvement and volunteerism 62% complete

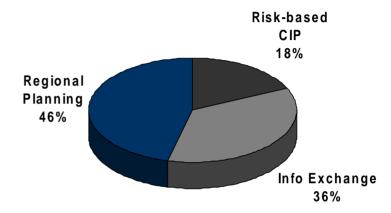


Goal 3: Prevention & Protection

- Develop common regional standards for planning, equipping, training, operating and exercising
 - ■Prevention and mitigation 72% complete
 - ■Exercises and training 92% complete
 - Health surveillance, detection, and mitigation 34% complete
 - ■Prevention and deterrence 0% complete
- Strengthen the analysis of information across disciplines for improved situational awareness
 - ■Information sharing and collaboration 87% complete
 - ■Personnel suitability 69% complete
- Employ a risk based approach to critical infrastructure protection across the NCR
 - ■Critical Infrastructure Protection protective actions 70% complete
 - Critical Infrastructure/ Key Resource inventory 7% complete

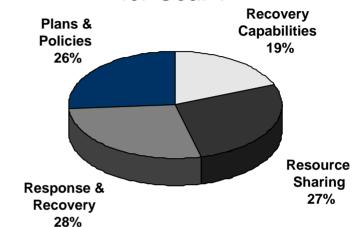


Goal 4: Response & Recovery

- Develop and implement integrated response and recovery plans, policies, and standards
 - Corrective action program 38% complete
 - •Align & integrate ESF plans 41% complete
 - Decontamination and re-entry 58% complete
- Strengthen all components of an integrated region wide response and recovery capability
 - Notification protocols 34% complete
 - NIMS adoption 34% complete
 - Interoperability 85% complete
- Improve and expand effective resource sharing systems and standards
 - Resource management 75% complete
 - Equipment interoperability standards 33% complete
 - Interdisciplinary protocols 38% complete
- ☐ Identify and close gaps in long-term recovery capabilities
 - Model & exercise 15 DHS scenarios 53% complete
 - Align resources with identified need 12% complete

A Breakdown of Two Priority Initiatives

Priority Initiative 3.2.1

Develop common regional information-sharing and collaboration frameworks, to include determining roles, responsibilities and protocols. Develop a system that allows for two-way communication flow between local, State, Regional and Federal operations centers in the NCR, to ensure that useful information is passed to the appropriate people in a timely fashion.

Priority Initiative 4.1.1

Establish a corrective action program to modify plans by addressing gaps identified in analyses, exercises, and events. Modify existing response and recovery plans, or develop new ones where necessary, to address gaps identified during exercises, real-world events, and the gap analysis conducted as part of Goal One.

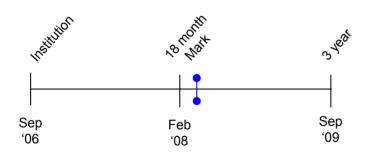

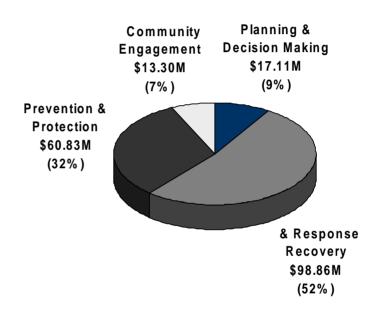


Percentage of Dollars Spent (To Date) by Strategic Goal (05-07 GY)
