

National Strategic Freight Plan

Jack Wells, chief economist at the U.S. Department of Transportation, details the agency's progress on a National Strategic Freight Plan. Congress last year ordered the department to craft a strategic freight plan by 2015, and the DOT is working with states and with private industry to pull the plan together. A DOT National Freight Advisory Committee began meeting in June and will advise the DOT on the National Stra-
