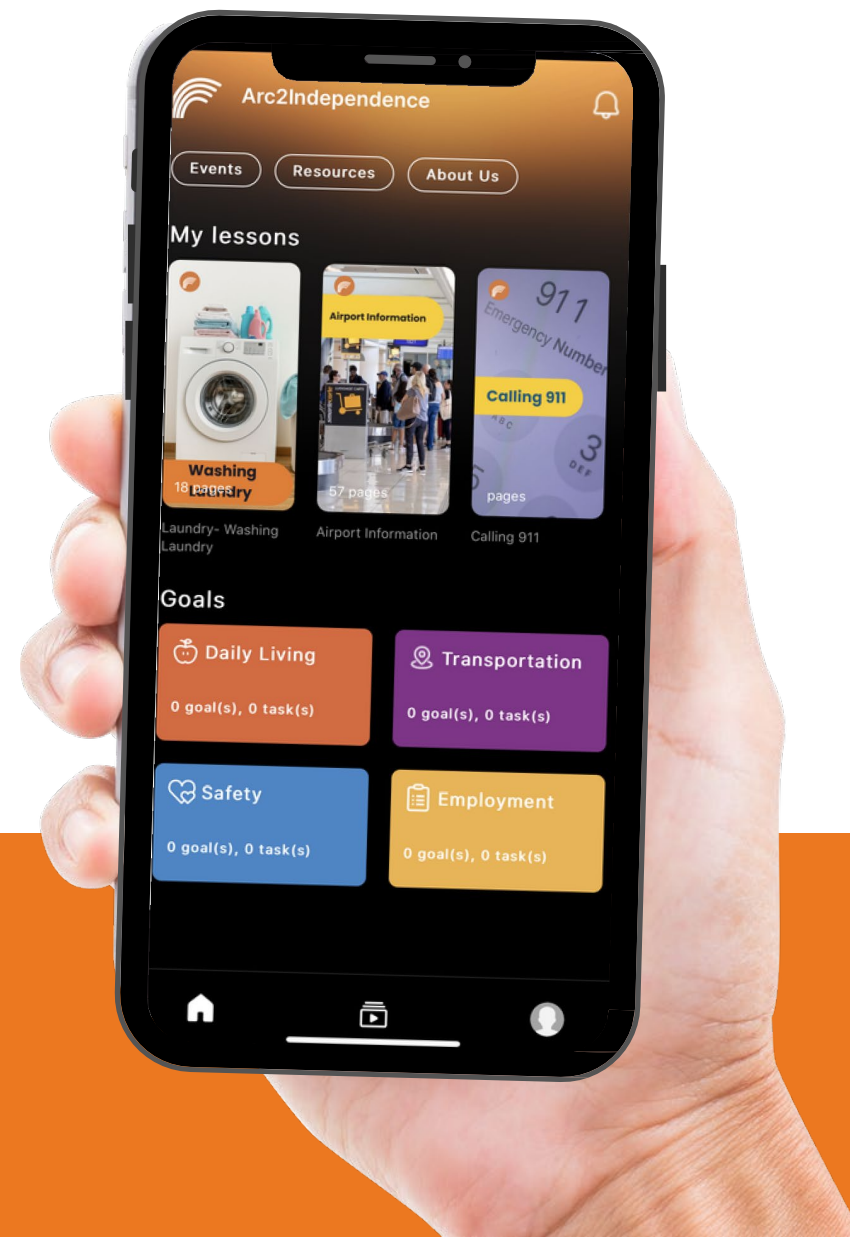

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## **2013-2016**

- Partnered with Oneder/Special Needsware to provide TravelMate
- 1 Full-Time Staff
- Primary focus on working with local school systems
- Available only through community partners
- Train the Trainer Model

## **2016-2018**

- 2 Full-Time Staff
- Expanded to working with employment providers and colleges

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## **2018-2020**

- Full-Time Staff, 1Part-Time Staff, 1Part-TimeSelf-Advocate

## **2020-2022**

- Oneder rebranded to Ori and the software became less able to meet the needs of our clients
- 2 Full-Time Staff, 1Part-Time SelfAdvocate

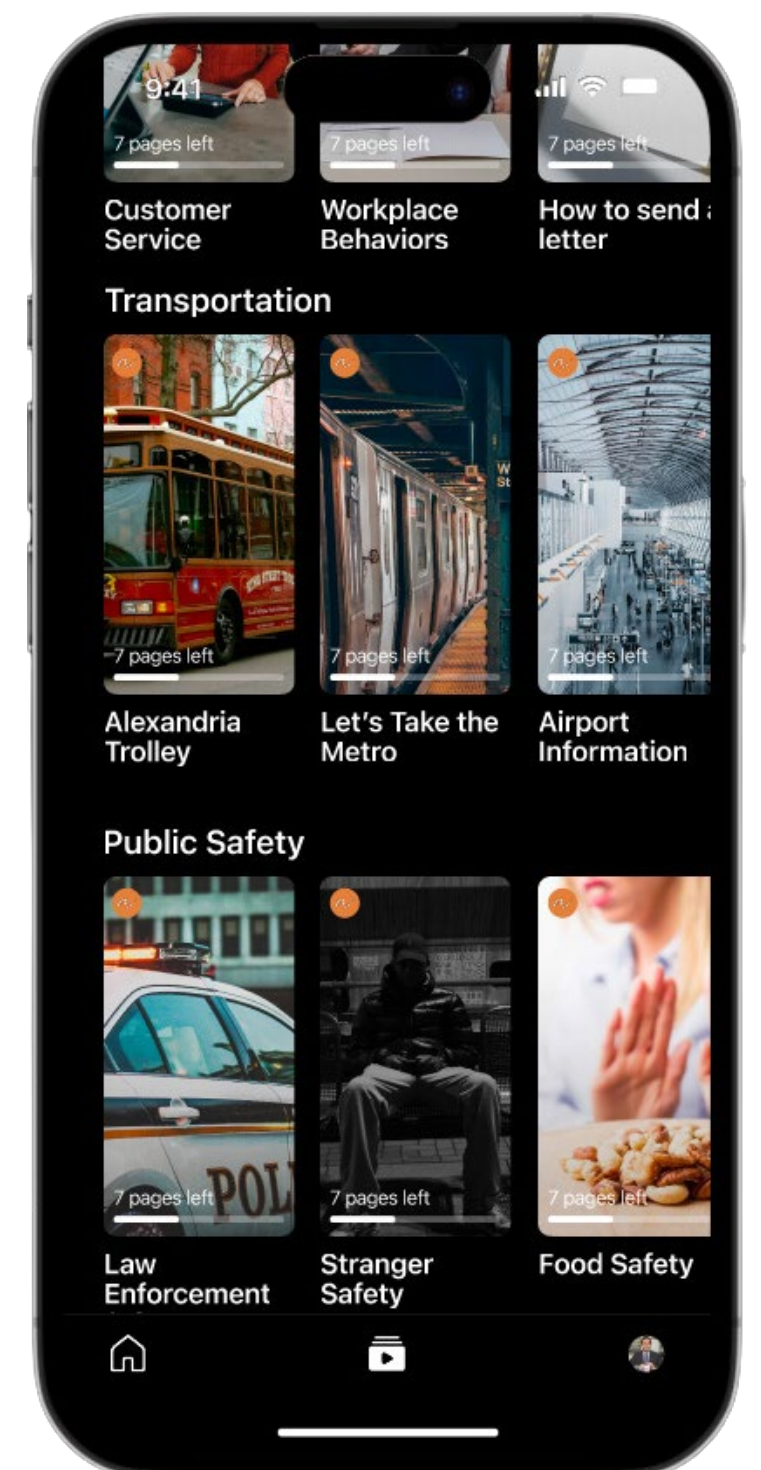
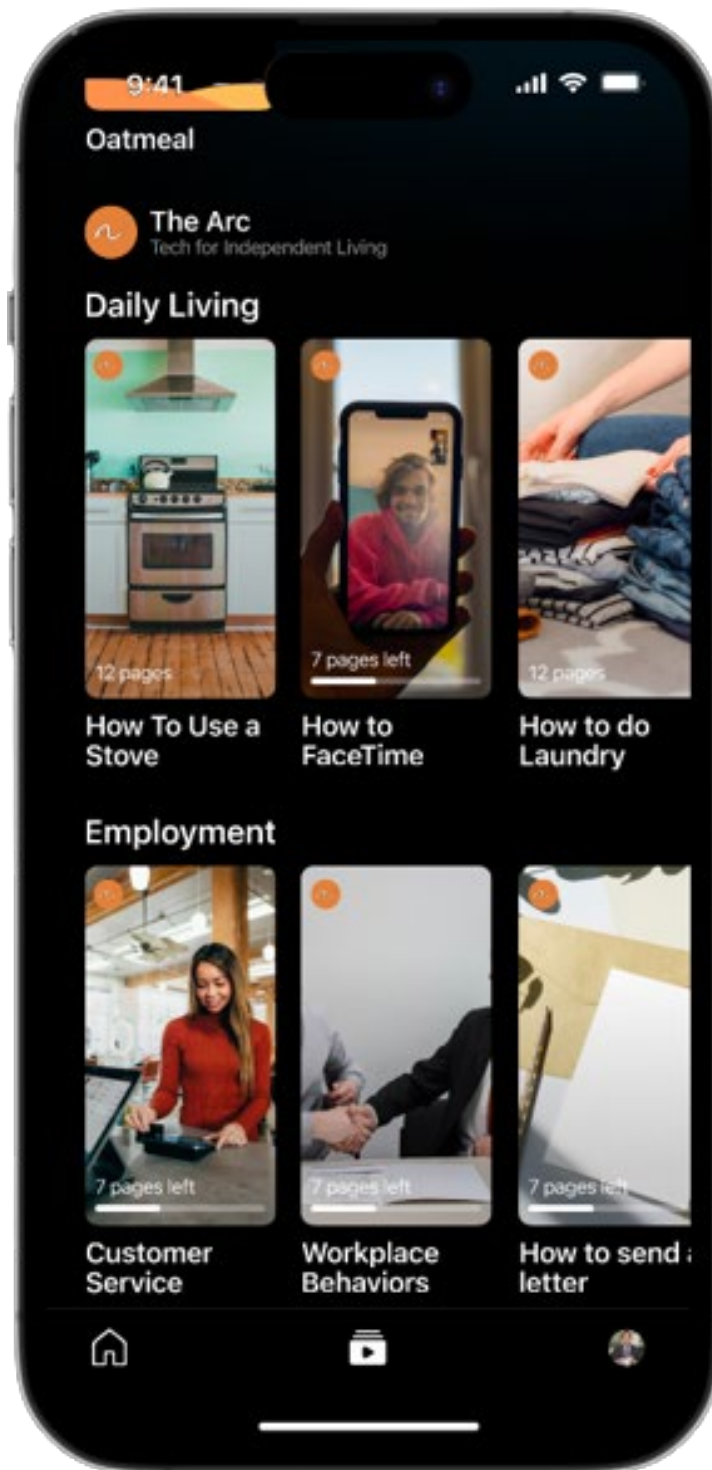
## **2022-24**

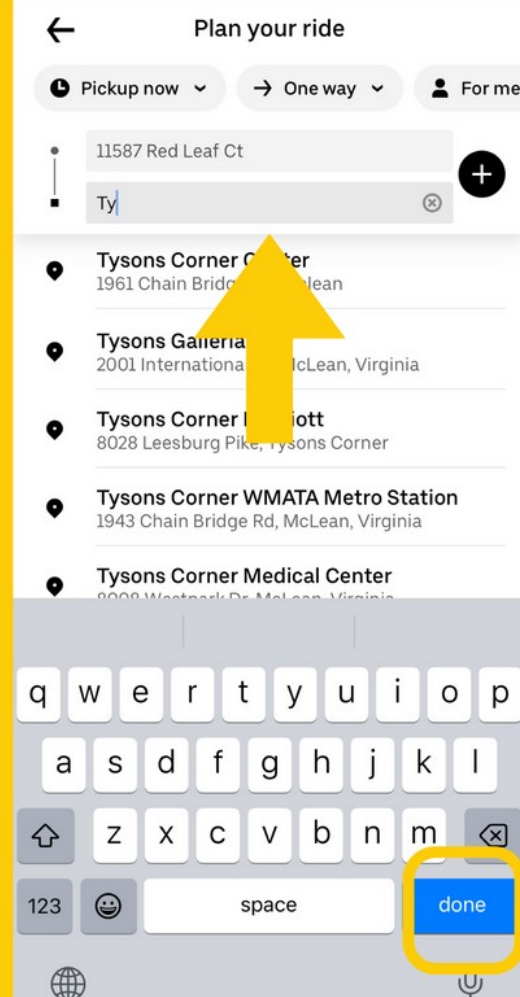
Tap the Home button if you are not already on the home page.



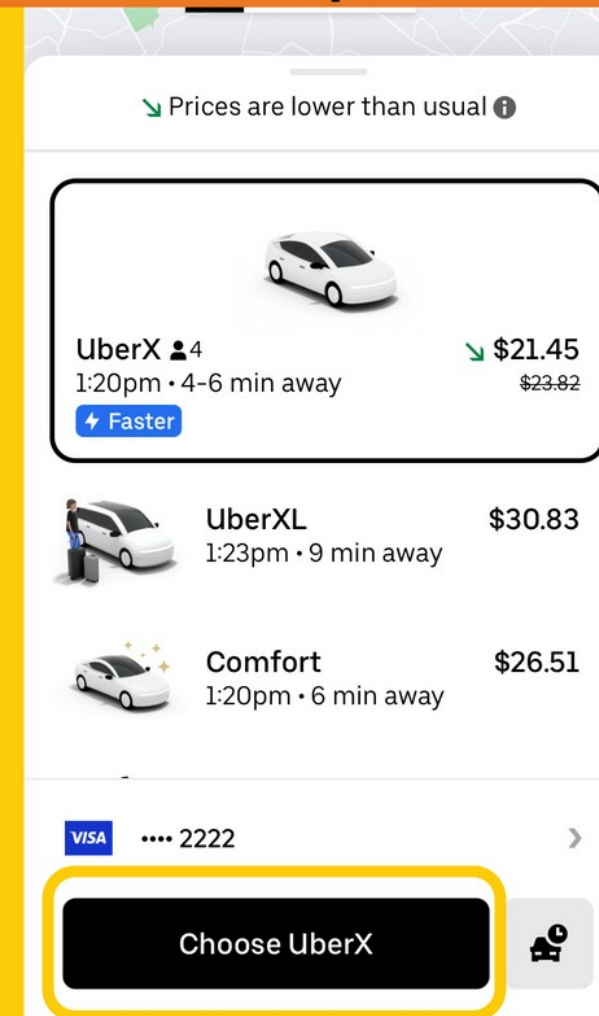
Tap the "Where to?" box under Rides.



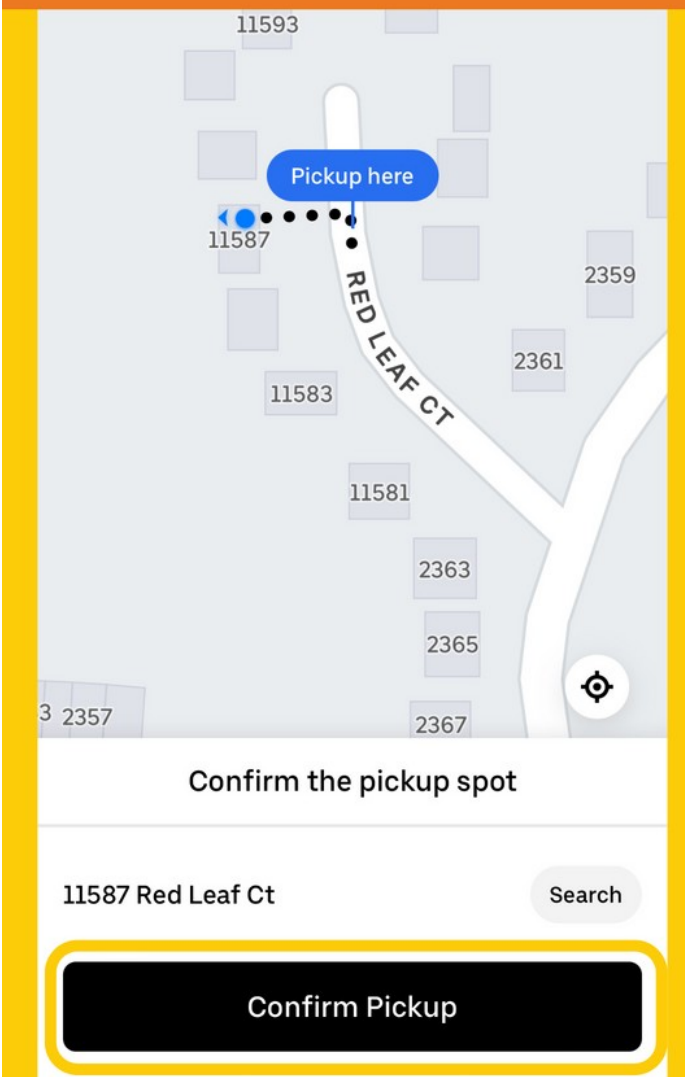
Type where you want to go and press the blue "done" button.



Choose the type of car you want. UberX is the fastest and cheapest.



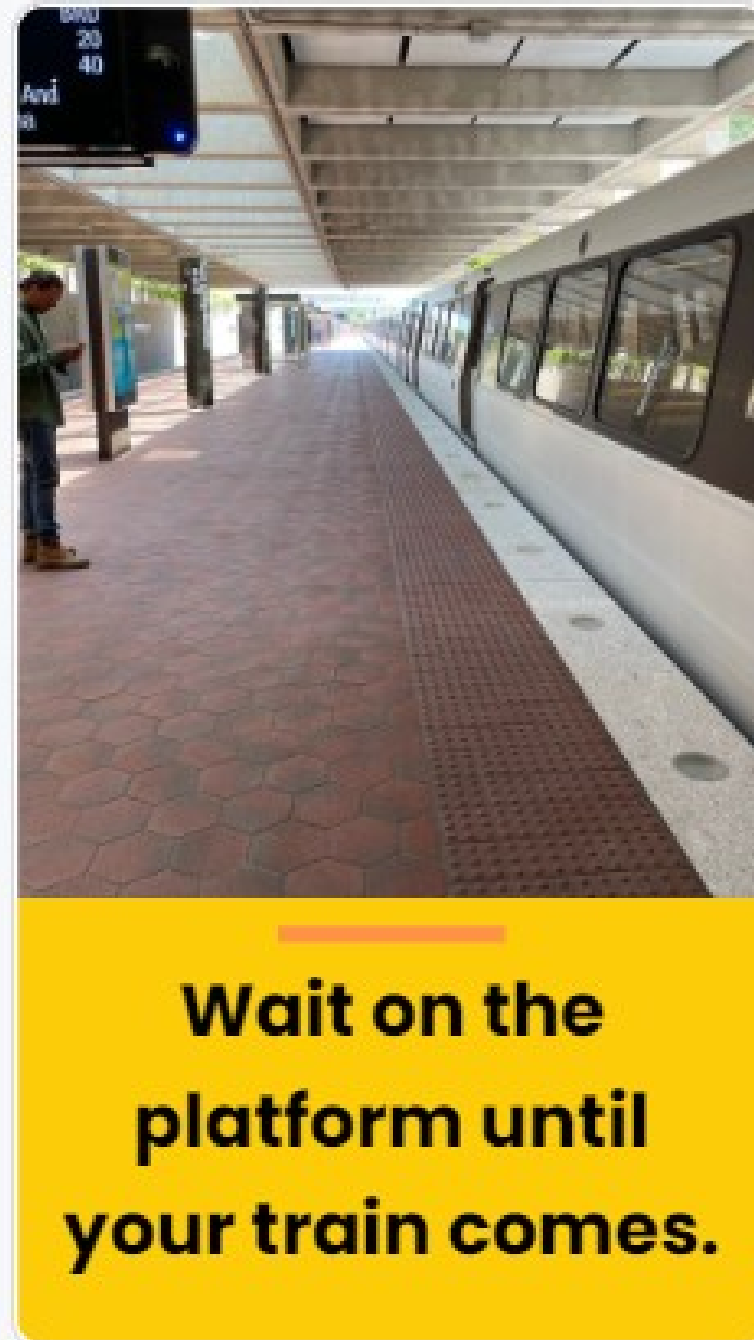
Press "Confirm Pickup" if the address is correct.



# Let's Take the Metro



**The Platform**



**Wait on the platform until your train comes.**



**Look up at the signs to find the train going to your destination. Stand on that side of the platform.**



**When a train arrives, read the sign on the train to make sure it says New Carrollton.**



# Pedestrian Safety

**When crossing the street, make sure to:**

**Look left, right, and left again to ensure no cars are coming.**



**When crossing the street, make sure to:**

**Only cross when it is safe.**

- When NO cars are coming.
- When the cars have stopped.



**When crossing the street, make sure to:**

**Signal the drivers.**

Put your hands out and make eye contact with the driver to ensure they stop and know you are crossing.



**When crossing the street, DO NOT:**

- Run across the street to beat a car.
- Look at your phone while crossing.
- Cross the street if it is not safe, even if others are crossing... **WAIT** till it is safe!





# Travel Related Fears

## FEAR



**I am afraid I won't know where to go.**



**Prepare yourself before your ride by looking up details related to your trip and planning.**

### **Plan the route you will take.**

- Using Google Maps or a local transit website, plan the route step-by-step
- Practice with a trusted person and take the trip with someone before doing it alone.
- Know when you need to get off and transfer



### **Plan the day of details for the trip.**

- Look up ticket costs and how to purchase one
- Look up the transportation schedule
- Pick people who you can talk to or text during your ride





# Stranger Safety

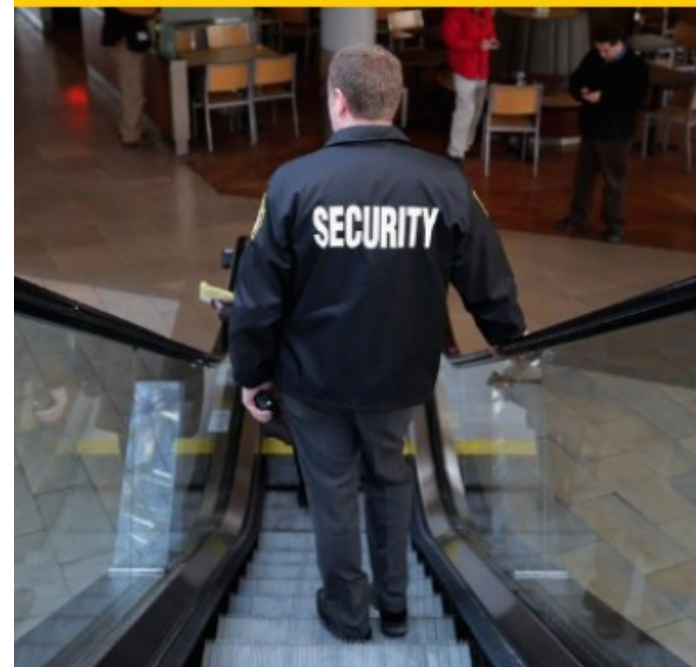
In the circles of relationships, strangers are the farthest away from you and your family.



Each day you see different strangers. The bus driver on your way to work, the cashier at the store, or a police officer on the sidewalk.



Strangers can be helpful like a security guard in the mall if you get lost or a server at a restaurant when you want to order your food.



Some strangers are dangerous and are not good people.




It is important to know the difference between "Safe Stranger" and an "Unsafe Stranger."



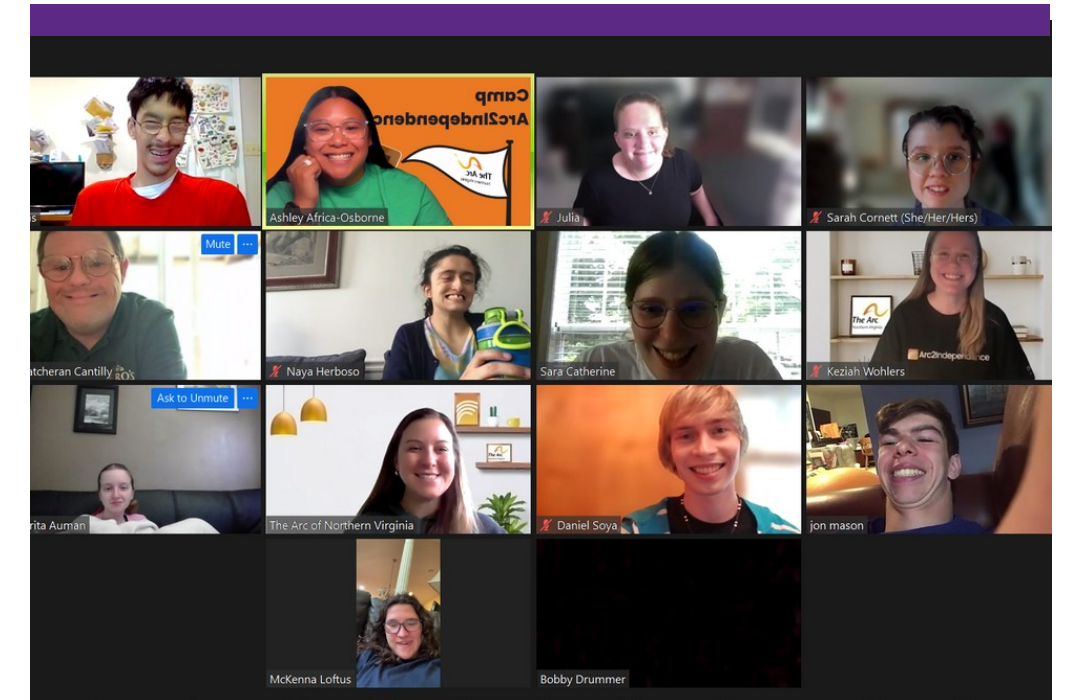

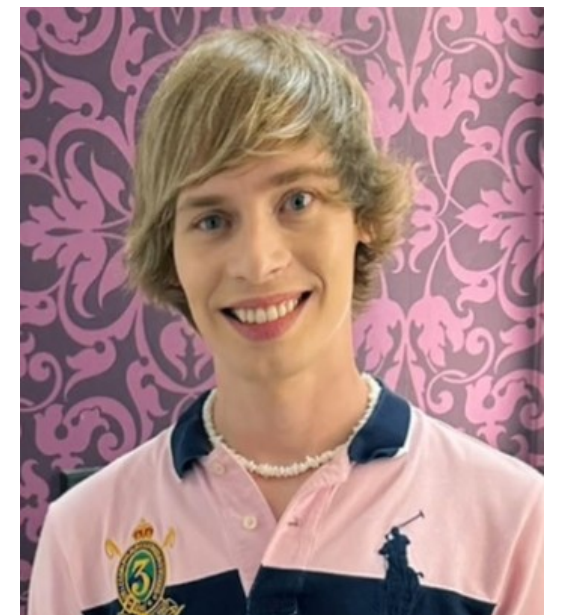
