The TPB Climate Change Mitigation Study of 2021 (CCMS) is a scenario study whose goal is to identify potential pathways for the region to reduce on-road, transportation-sector greenhouse gas emissions to meet COG's regional greenhouse gas (GHG) reduction goals associated with 2030 and 2050. The analysis phase of the study is now complete and Mr. Grant, ICF, will provide a detailed briefing on the results of the analysis. A draft of the final report, which documents the analysis of three top-down scenarios and 10 bottom-up scenarios, has been made available. The TPB will receive an abbreviated briefing on the results at its regular meeting on Wednesday, December 15.
