

**TPB Technical Committee Meeting Highlights      June 6, 2003**

The Technical Committee met on Friday, June 6 at COG. Five items were reviewed for inclusion on the TPB agenda on June 18.

\$      TPB agenda Item 7

The Committee reviewed the draft scope of work for the air quality conformity assessment for the 2003 CLRP and FY 2004-2009 TIP, and recommended that the Board approve the work scope.

\$      TPB agenda Item 12

The Committee was briefed by consultant staff on the incomplete draft results of the financial analysis for the 2003 update of the CLRP. The Committee recommended that the projections be completed and presented to the Board so that it can address the identified funding shortfalls in WMATA's capital and operating requests.

\$      TPB agenda Item 13

DEP staff briefed the Committee on the region's new state implementation plan (SIP) which was approved for public hearings by the Metropolitan Washington Air Quality Committee (MWAQC) on May 28. DTP staff briefed the Committee on the Transportation Control Measures (TCMs) proposed for the new SIP, the proposed mobile budgets in the SIP for determining transportation air quality conformity of the 2003 CLRP and FY 2004-2009 TIP, and potential Transportation Emissions Reduction Measures (TERMs).

\$      TPB agenda Item 10

Consultant staff briefed the Committee on research and initial communications and marketing strategies for the regional Mass Marketing TERM, which is being implemented by Commuter Connections to influence single occupant drivers to switch to transit, ride share, and tele-work.

\$      TPB agenda Item 11

The Committee was briefed on the discussions and outcome of the June 4 TPB Conference on "Value Pricing for Transportation in the Washington Region."

Three items were presented for information and discussion:

\$      Staff briefed the Committee on the preliminary draft FY 2004-2009 TIP document. The Board will be briefed on the draft FY 2004-2009 TIP at its July 16 meeting.

\$      Staff briefed the Committee on the responses to the comments received on the draft

report on the Spring 2002 count of peak period persons and vehicles entering and exiting the central employment area of the District of Columbia and Arlington County. (The Committee changed the "Metro Core" designation in the report to the "Central Employment Area" to remove confusion with the term "regional core" used in the TPB Transportation Vision.) After review by the Committee, a presentation on this report will be scheduled at a future TPB meeting.

\$ Staff updated the Committee on current activities to develop alternative transportation and land use scenarios for the Regional Mobility and Accessibility Study. The next meeting of the Joint Technical Working Group (JTWG) for this study is scheduled for June 13.
