MWAQC's Mission

- Formulate, adopt, and submit, to DC, MD, and VA, a proposed regional air quality plan for incorporation into applicable State Implementation Plans (SIPs).
- Develop air quality maintenance plans which include measures and implementation commitments for consideration and incorporation into SIPs and implementation by the local governments, the states, and the US EPA.
- Fulfill any other functions and obligations necessary for promulgation and maintenance of regional air quality policies, plans, or programs as may be assigned by federal and state statute.
- At the request of state or local jurisdictions, perform other functions to enhance regional air quality.



EJ Subcommittee Role

- The Environmental Justice Subcommittee has been established to support MWAQC's commitment to incorporating environmental justice and equity in its work program.
- The subcommittee's mission is to develop policies and initiatives to support its members environmental justice/equity programs.
- The subcommittee will work collaboratively with stakeholders to develop an Action Plan to provide implementation strategies to integrate equity into policies, programs, and projects related to air quality.
- Sunset Date one year (12-months) from kickoff meeting and delivering final Action Plan.



EJ Action Plan Deliverables

- Action Plan Technical Memo
 - Memo will include analysis of existing air monitoring date and area specific health studies. It will identify gaps in current air quality knowledge. Review of EJ analysis and best practices and climate change impacts.
- Engagement Report
 - Report on results of stakeholder outreach and engagement and resulting implementation
- Action Plan outline
 - Draft Action Plan
 - Final Action Plan
 - Action Plan summary presentation



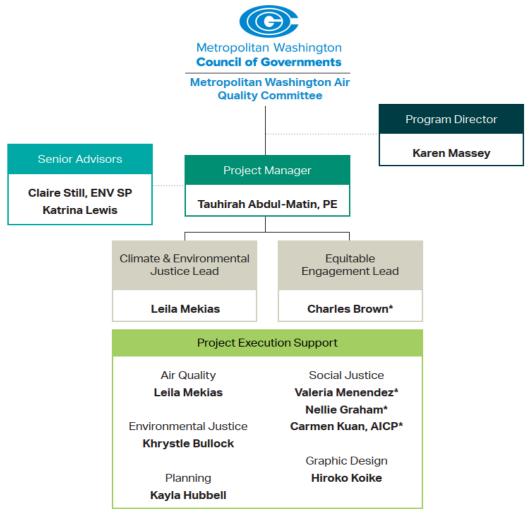

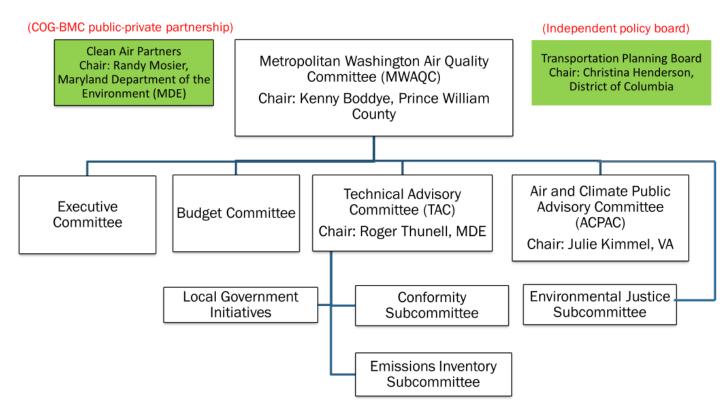

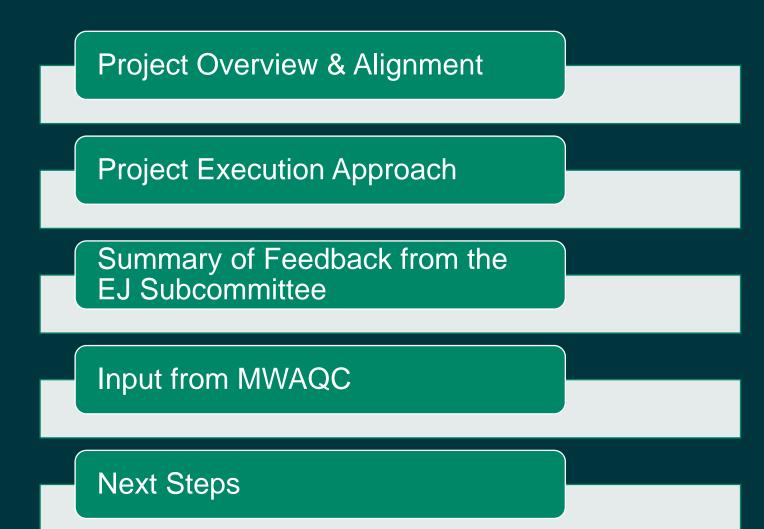
MWAQC Organizational Structure

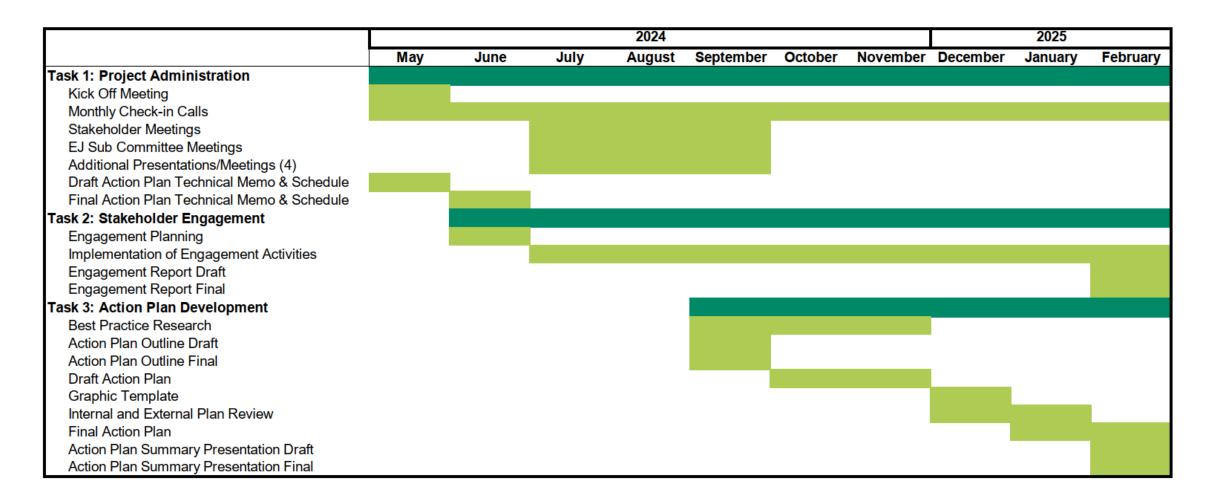

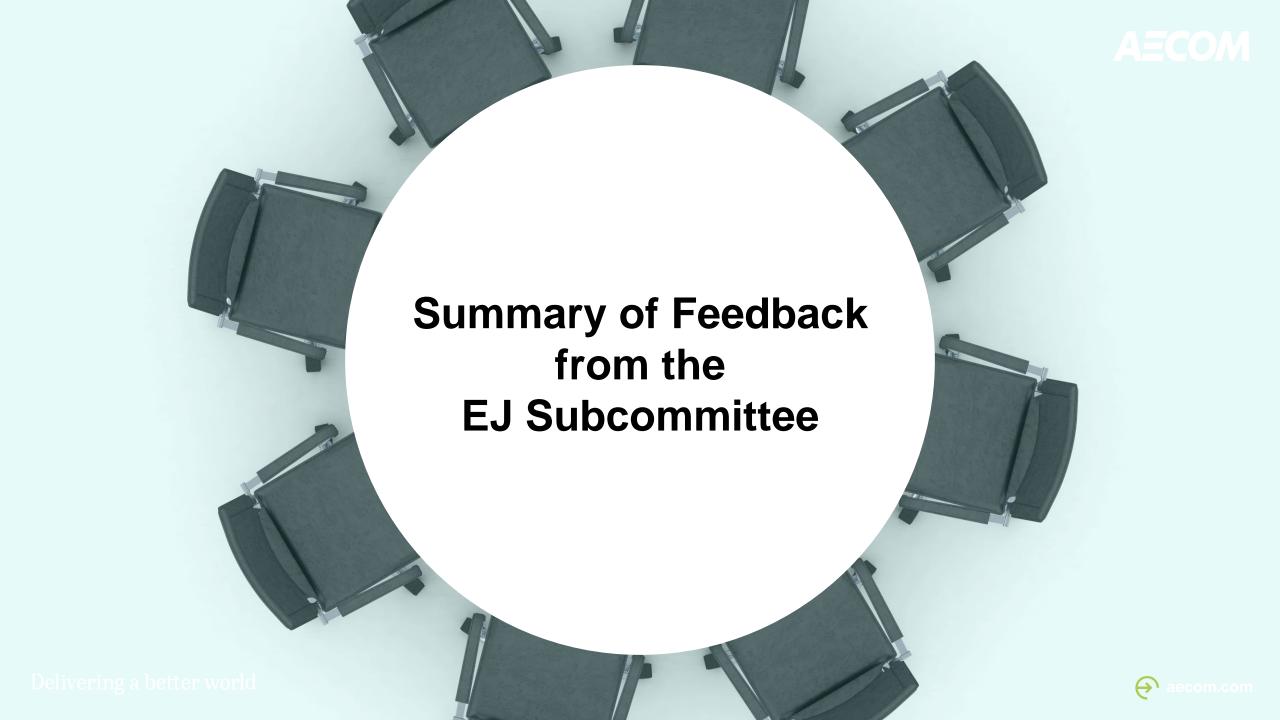

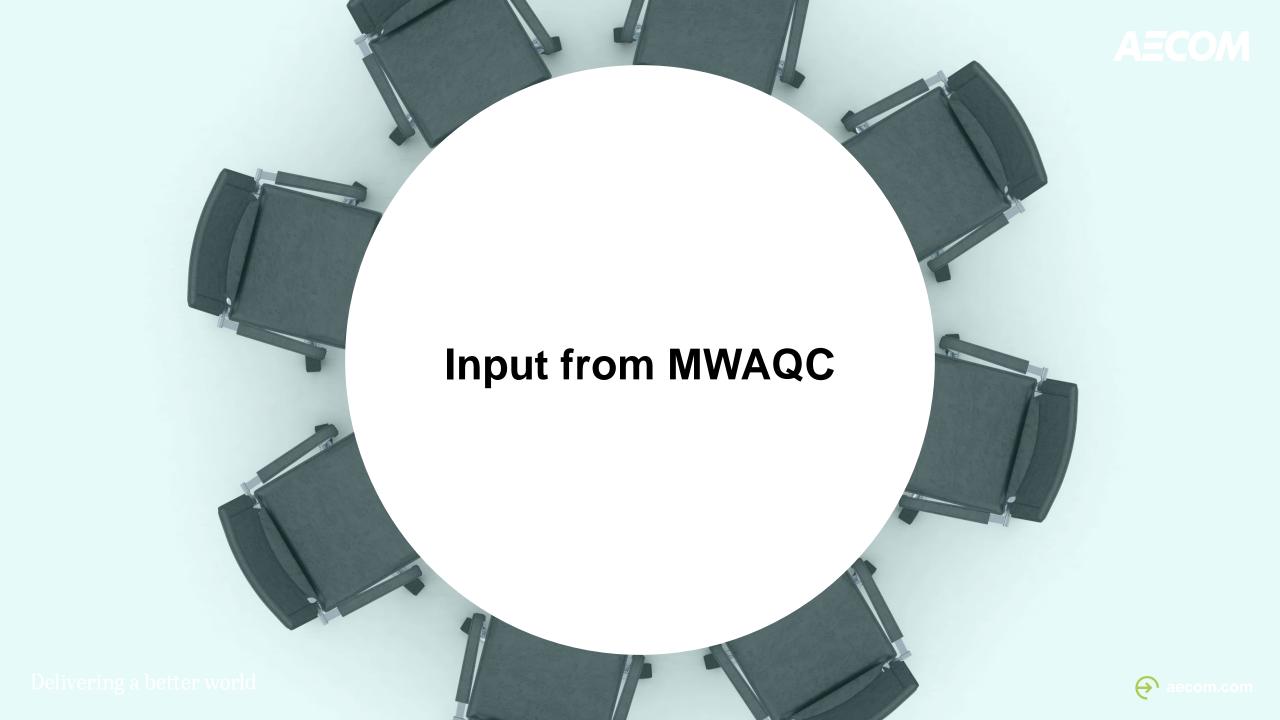




Input from EJ Subcommittee
