 POLICY ADVISORY COMMITTEES}

WHEREAS, the bylaws of the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (COG) authorize the Board of Directors to establish policy advisory committees in high priority areas; and

WHEREAS, these policy advisory committees play a vital role in supporting and updating the Board on various topics; and

WHEREAS, the COG's bylaws also authorize the Board of Directors to nominate the Chair of the policy committees; and

WHEREAS, the following policy committees support the COG Board of Directors: Metropolitan Development Policy Committee (MDPC), Human Services Policy Committee (HSPC), Public Safety Policy Committee (PSPC), Aviation Policy Committee, Chesapeake Bay Policy Committee (CBPC); and

WHEREAS, the COG Board also established the National Capital Region Emergency Preparedness Council (NCREPC) to advise COG on national security and emergency preparedness issues, and further authorized the COG Board to appoint the NCREPC Chair.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE METROPOLITAN WASHINGTON COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS THAT:

1. The Board of Directors approves, for 2007, the appointment of the following members as Chair of their respective policy advisory committees: MDPC- Tom Dernoga, Prince George's County; HSPC- George Leventhal, Montgomery County; PSPC- Terry Seamens, City of Takoma Park; CBPC- Martin Nohe, Prince William County; and the reappointment of Rob Krupicka, City of Alexandria, to the Aviation Policy Committee. Gerald Connolly, Fairfax County, is appointed as Chair of the NCREPC.
2. Additional 2007 appointments for Vice Chair to the policy advisory committees will be made as COG receives notice from its member governments.
