THE REGIONAL ECONOMIC MONITORING SYSTEM (REMS) REPORT – JANUARY 2024

In December, over-the-year employment increased by 38,100 jobs or 1.1 percent in the Washington Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA), while the national over-the-year employment increased by about 2.9 million jobs or 1.9 percent. Locally, the Leisure & Hospitality Sector gained 12,300 jobs and the Educational & Health Services Sector gained 16,400 jobs during the last year. (373,800 jobs were lost between March 2020 and April 2020) The Washington region has gained 432,400 jobs between April 2020 and December 2023 – 101.8 percent. The region's inflation decreased in November to 2.8 percent from a rate of 3.3 percent in September. During December, the region's unemployment rate remained at 2.5 percent, while the national rate remained at 3.5 percent. The 1,775 new housing units authorized during December 2023 represent a 36.4 percent decrease from December 2022, when 2,793 new units were started. 
Over-the-Year Inflation Rate Washington MSA and US


Unemployment Rate Washington MSA and US



At-Place Employment - The number of jobs within a given area. Although some employment data include the number of areas residents who have jobs, at-place employment counts the actual number of jobs in an area.
