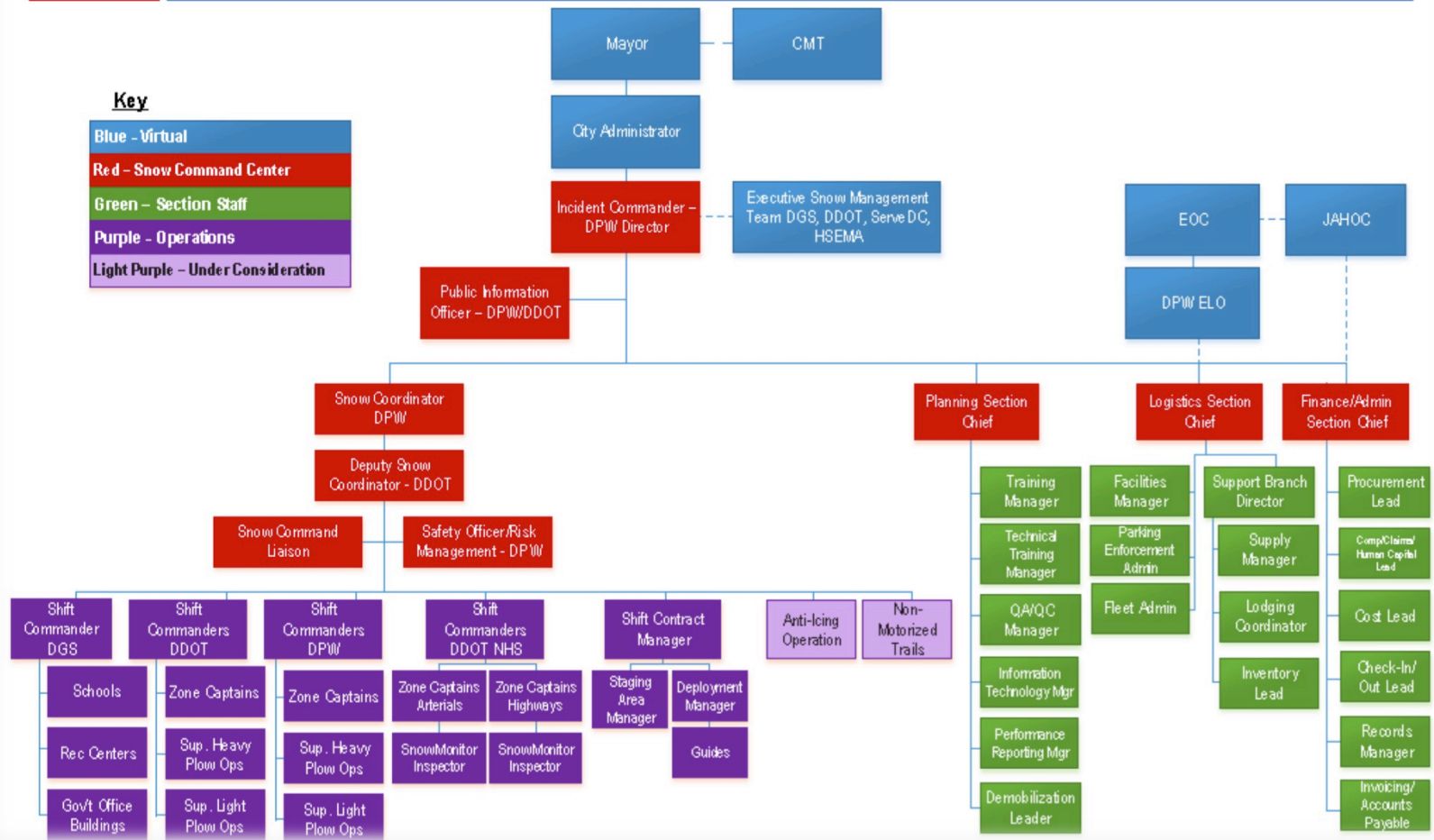

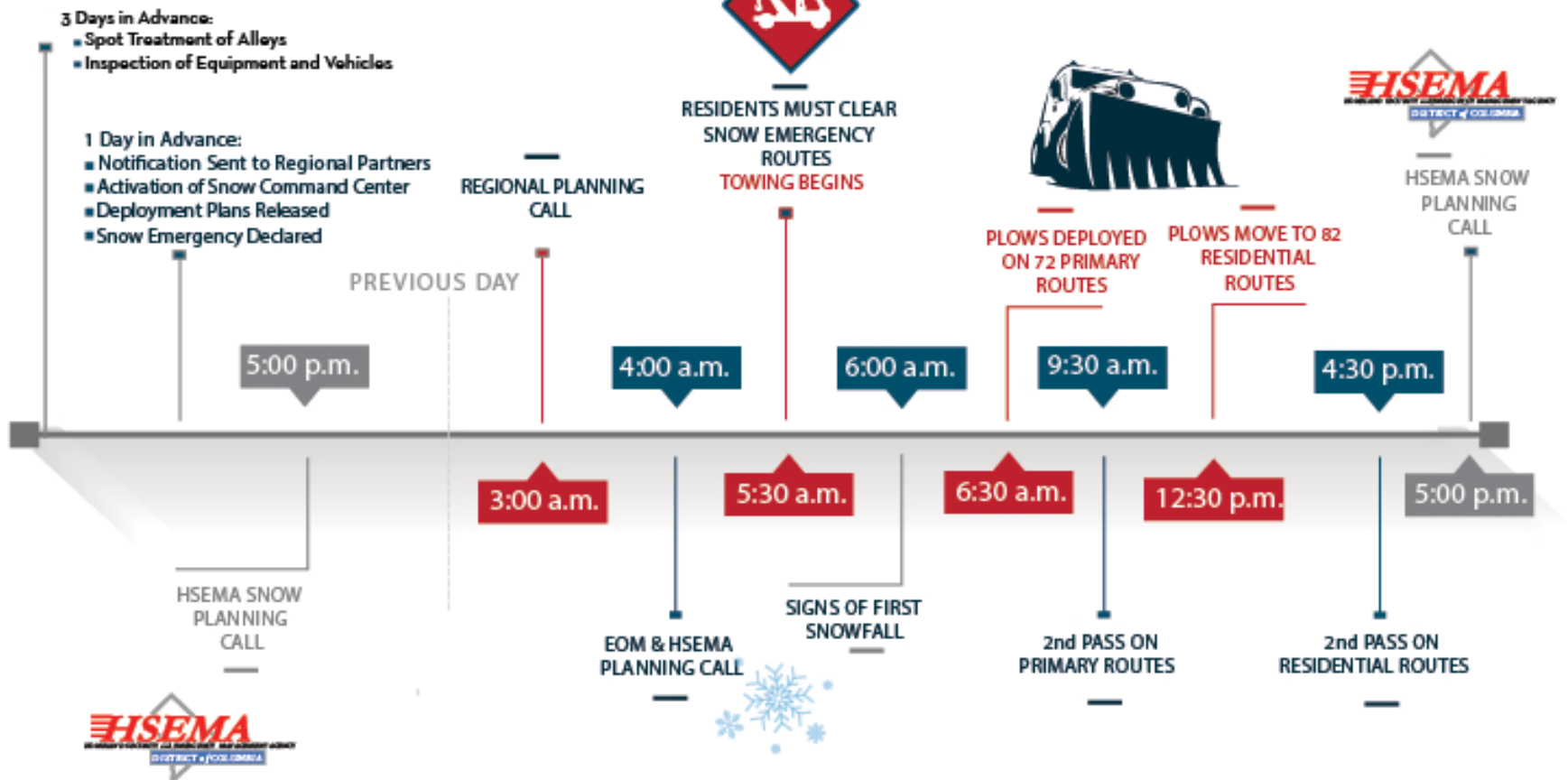

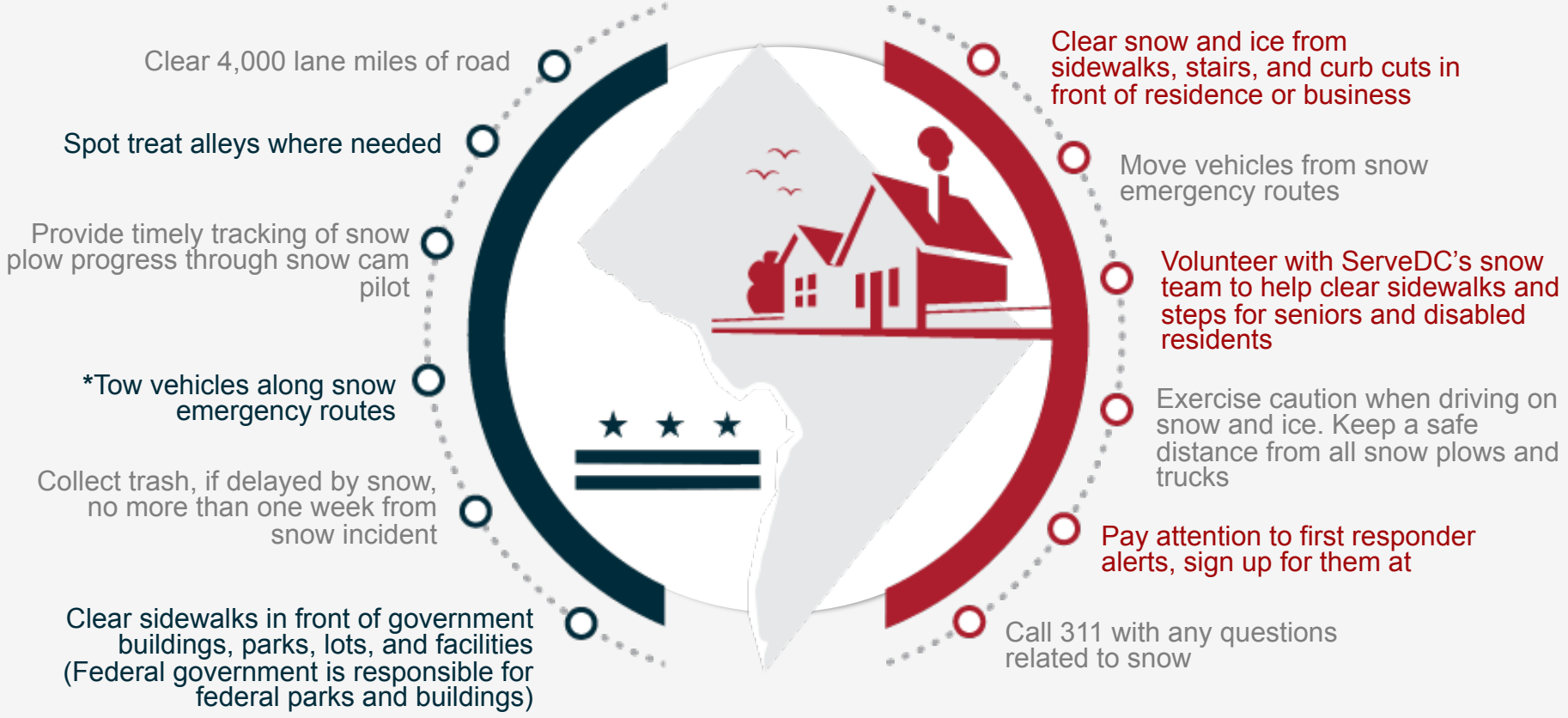


Winter Event Response Timeline

*There is a **\$100 Tow Fee**, and a **\$250 Snow Emergency Violation Ticket** issued to all vehicles towed. If a vehicle is impounded there is a **\$20 a day storage fee**. Most vehicles are relocated to other residential streets instead of being impounded. Residents may call 311 to locate their towed car.
