The data is critical for identifying safety problems and trends, as well as for determining the level of success in achieving DDOT's highway safety goals.

HAWK signals stop vehicles to allow protected pedestrian crossings when activated. Although considered experimental until only recently, they have been installed in several jurisdictions around the region. Mr. Branyan will present on DDOT's experience with HAWK signals.

The subcommittee will have a chance to review and discuss 2013 crash data. The discussion will include a timeline for the introduction of new data as required by MAP-21 regulations and the mapping of FARS data.
